

Travel Destination: Asia

Topic: Communication

Challenge: I SEE, WE BUILD Lego Build

1. Select three team members to play. Have one person sit in chair facing the opposite way of the labeled lego box.
 - a. This participant (the builder) will receive one bag of LEGOs, disassembled.
 2. The other participants are the communicators. They can travel to the built lego model in the labeled lego box and look at the finished model. They may NOT show it to their teammate in the chair behind them.
 3. In the builder's bag are the same lego pieces (size and number) however, they are NOT the same color. Not all lego pieces will be used.
- The participants with the model: You may talk, but cannot look at the builder's model.
- The Builder: You may build, but cannot ask questions. Other communication is allowed.
- The group: You may not help. But can encourage your teammates!

Once your model is built, you may check in with the judge. Do not turn around or check lego models until judge has checked your work.

Once successfully completed, travel to the pit stop with your team to hear your next destination!

Travel Destination: North America

Topic: Active

Select 2 Detour numbers out of the bag to see which ones your team will complete!

Detour #1: Cotton Ball Relay Race

For this challenge, you must race the clock and transport as many cotton balls as possible under one minute! Select one team member to sit in the chair and hold a bowl above their head. The other team members need to start on the other side of the tape line. (Near the bowl of cotton balls and spoon.) One by one, each person will transfer 1 cotton ball on a spoon to the empty bowl on their teammate's head.

Your Goal: Transfer 10 cotton balls in 60 seconds. Do not move onto the next detour until this is successfully completed!

If not successful, retry the detour relay. If not successful after 2 attempts, judge will place an X on continent map in passport.

Detour #2: Noodling Around

Select one player to pick up and stack six penne noodles placed around the perimeter of a table using only one piece of uncooked spaghetti, in their mouth - in less than 1 minute!

If not successful, retry the detour with a new person. If not successful after 2 attempts, judge will place an X on continent map in passport.

Detour #3: This Blows!

Selected player must continually blow up a balloon and expel the air from it to knock 10 cups off of a table in under one minute!

If not successful, retry the detour with a new person. If not successful after 2 attempts, judge will place an X on continent map in passport.

Detour #4: Paper Dragon

Choose one player to un-spool 2 rolls of party streamers using only their hands and arms, as fast as possible, again under 1 minute! THIS DETOUR CAN ONLY BE ATTEMPTED ONCE. If not successful after 1 attempt, judge will place an X on continent map in passport.

Once two Detours are completed, travel as a team to the pit stop and learn your next destination!

Travel Destination: Australia

Topic: Innovation

Challenge: Faculty Meeting Passcode

Work as a team to unlock the code and break open the box to find your next destination. Don't move on until you unlock the box! Work quietly so you don't give away answers to the other teams.

Travel Destination: South America

Topic: Collaboration

Challenge: Plastic Cup Pyramid

The challenge is to build a pyramid out of the paper cups (3 on the bottom, 2 in the middle, 1 on the top).

Group members cannot touch the cups with their hands or any other part of their bodies, even if a cup falls over or on the floor.

First have each member tie string to rubber band. Each person holds onto one of the strings that are attached to the rubber band and then use this device to pick up the cups and place them on top of each other.

Once successfully completed, travel to the pit stop with your team!
