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#### Purpose

Provide leadership and support for **The Bridge**, Montecito Covenant Church (MCC)'s midweek ministry for pre-teen and junior high school students (7th–8th grade), fostering a safe, welcoming space where students explore faith and community.

#### Key Responsibilities

- Assist in planning, preparing, and leading weekly **Bridge** gatherings.
- Coordinate and lead volunteer program staff.
- Maintain consistent, positive communication with students and their families, including program updates, invitations, and timely follow-up that fosters ongoing relationships and engagement.
- Support volunteer training and track attendance.
- Participate in MCC's intern program and assist with additional church programs as needed.

#### Qualifications

- Passion for working with pre-teens and middle schoolers; prior youth ministry or camp experience preferred.
- Strong communication, relational, and leadership skills.
- Able to work independently and collaboratively.
- Completion of MCC's volunteer screening process.
- Preference will be given to applicants able to commit to the full academic year.

#### Expectations

- Full participation in MCC's ministry internship program, including making MCC your church home for the duration of your participation/employment.
