1. Opening Business

A. Agenda Approval - approved

B. November Minutes - approved

C. Good News Reports - Mr. Sageser shared that the Academic Team has been undefeated and gave a shout out to Mr. Burton, the Academic Team coach. He noted that they are excited for districts. Mr. Sageser also shared that it is KSA spirit week and that the school is having an awards ceremony Wednesday and pep rally on Friday to celebrate test scores.

2. Planning

A. CSIP (2023-24) Review - Mr. Sageser explained that upon approval of CSIP we will update our CSIP.

Proficiency Goals

- To surpass the state proficient and distinguished average in Reading and Mathematics by 2024-25.
- To surpass the state proficient and distinguished average in Science, Social Studies, and Writing by 2024-25.
- Ensure that teachers are designing and delivering quality instruction and practices.

Achievement Gap

- Decrease the students with novice On-Demand Writing scores from 19% in 2022-2023 to 10% in 2023-2024.
- Decrease the students with novice Reading scores from 38% in 2022-2023 to 25% in 2023-2024.
- Decrease the students with novice Math scores from 47% in 2022-2023 to 25% in 2023-2024.

English Learner Progress

- All students in the EL group at HCHS will move at least .5 level as measured by ACCESS by spring of 2023.

Quality of School Climate and Safety

- To improve the consistency of behavior expectations and implementation.
- To improve the overall respect between students on a daily basis.

Postsecondary Readiness

- Increase students being Postsecondary Ready from 93.2% in 2022-2023 to 94% in 2023-2024.
- Increase Special Education students being Postsecondary from 54.5% in 2022-2023 to 60% in 2023-2024.

Graduation Rate

- Increase the graduation rate from 89.1% in 2022-2023 to 94% in 2023-2024.

B. SBDM Budget Review/Budget Update Approval - approved

Mr. Sageser explained the budget, final allocations, daily attendance, and why there have been changes/adjustments made.

C. 2024-25 CSIP Approval - Mr. Sageser read through the new plan and it was approved by the council so it can now be presented to the Board for approval.
