Pledge of Allegiance

Meeting called to order by Chairman Laubach. Present: Jason Hagen, Greg Zarbok, David Sibell, Matt Laubach, Paul Olson, Gregg Jacobson, Angela Hennen. Mike Frederick, Austin Birch, Dana Oelkers. Kathryn and Mike Chevalier, Steve Paskewitz.

Motion Zarbok, second Jacobson to approve minutes of 1-13-26 - passed.

Treasurer report given by Hennen. Beginning balance - \$906,821.71. Outstanding \$120,313.73

Checking account - \$205,361.91

Money Market savings - \$821,773.68

Motion Olson, second Zarbok to approve - passed

Steve Paskewitz from West Marlu Estates came to the meeting asking the Township to take over the road in the Morton Addition off of 205th. Paskewitz stated there are seven owners there (all of the lots have sold) and the road is approximately 1/2 mile long. Kathryn and Mike Chevalier in lots #7 and #8 stated that the road is already up to Township standards. Laubach stated that 50%+ 1 permanent residence are required in order for this to occur. Laubach stated that it requires eight signatures within three miles on the petition. Mike Frederick to inspect the road.

Budget discussed. Motion Zarbok, second Jacobson to approve the \$570,875.00 budget - passed.

Discussion of the Whittemore zoning request. Motion Jacobson, second Laubach to begin looking for another zoning administrator for the Township - passed.

Discussion of 200th past the landfill with no numbers presently.

Jacobson requested that the five-year plan to be discussed after the new Board members are present in March.

Oelkers was not able to procure a van for transportation for the upcoming Township road tour.

Motion Zarbok, second Olson to grant Clerk Sibell rights to appoint election judges for the annual March election - passed.

Question by Jacobson on Brett Braaten's construction of a new shed (#09-0432-602). No action taken.

Motion Zarbok, second Hagen to pay bills from check #9484 to check #9500 in the amount of \$7,945.16 - passed.

Motion Zarbok, second Hagen to adjourn.
