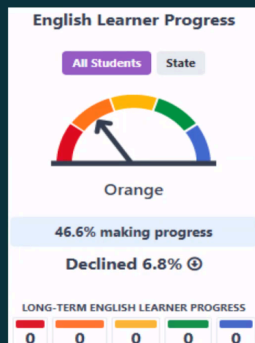

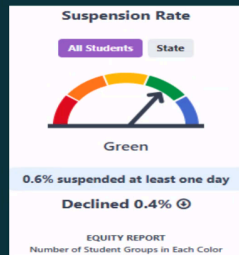

By May 2026, 58% of all Multilingual Learners will make progress as measured by the overall English Language Progress Indicator.

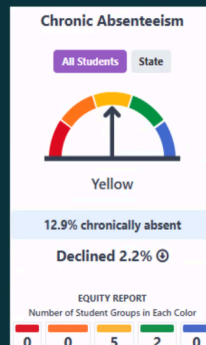
