As we prepare ourselves for the possibility of inclement weather and increased cases of COVID-19 in our community that necessitate quarantining of a large number of students and staff, I wanted to remind everyone of the schedules that will be implemented on these days. We will be implementing the virtual learning schedule linked below. Please select the level on the tabs along the bottom for specific schedules. Please be mindful of this information.

NOTE - Elementary students already enrolled in voluntary distance learning classes will continue to follow that schedule on inclement weather or COVID-19 closure days.

In the event of **the need to call a late arrival, middle school and high school students** and staff will not come to school and follow the **School Closure Distance Learning Schedule**.

In the event of **the need to call a late arrival, elementary school students and staff will follow the normal delay schedule. Elementary students who are Voluntary Distance Learning will follow their normal schedule. Teachers providing Voluntary Distance Learning will work from home and follow their normal schedule.**

Also, please make sure that your child is prepared to learn virtually each day in the event of a school closure. This means reviewing with them the need to bring home all necessary materials daily. I am hopeful we never, or at the very least seldom, have to implement such days; however, we need to be prepared so that learning can continue.
