By now you should have received an email confirming what club/s your child has been successful in gaining a place on. All clubs re-start next week w/c 15th September. On the day's your child is attending a sports club please make sure they bring in a change of clothes and trainers. They will be given time to change in their year

If for any reason your child **cannot attend** a club it is your responsibility to let the office know at your earliest convenience. If we have not been notified we will contact you to make sure they have collected safely. It is really important that we know where they are if they were due to attend a club.

Vale Community Lunchtime

We have been trialling new lunchtime arrangements since the start of term to provide the best experience for the children and staff. In particular, we wanted to bring children together in their houses to enjoy the social aspect of eating and chatting together. This has provided children with opportunities to talk to people they haven't spoken to before and build on their social skills and confidence.

We are working closely with Chartwells to bring about this positive change and ensure an enjoyable lunch for all.

We are pleased to have already received such positive feedback from staff and pupils and it has been an absolute joy to see the children smiling, chatting and enjoying their lunch together.

The main changes are:

- Children having packed lunch or a hot meal now eat together in the halls
- Both our halls are now open to accommodate all the children picture Hogwarts style!
- Children have a full 30 minutes in the lunch hall and 30 minutes outside play
- Children sit in their house colours, in their phase year groups on a staggered timetable for service and eating e.g. Yr 1/2 together, Yr 3/4 together and Yr 5/6 together
- Yrs 1-6 have the same lunchtime 12:15-1:15 / Early Years 12-1pm
- We promote independence with cutlery caddies on the table for pupils to lay their own place, pupils clear away their plate and collect their pudding.
- We promote good manners and excellent behaviour in the lunch hall so that everyone can enjoy this time together

Height and Weight Checks for Children in Year 6

Every year in England, school children in reception and year 6 have their height and weight checked at school. This is called the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). The checks are carried out by members of the Healthy Child Programme (HCP) 5-19 team who have been appropriately trained. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils. The programme will be delivered in a safe way, in line with the school and local authority's safety control measures and national guidance for schools and healthcare. You can watch the NCMP process animation. The animation explains the process of the NCMP and why it is important. It will guide you through what it involves, how your child's data is collected and processed and what it will be used for.

Year 6 parents would have received more information on this this week and a date the screening will take place is to follow. Reception children screening will be done later in the academic year and information will be sent to those parents nearer the time.
