Stamps: Stippled Roses*, Thoughtful Expressions*,

Ringed With Nature

Paper: Smokey Slate Cardstock, Bubble Bath

Cardstock, Basic White Cardstock

Ink: Basic Gray, Bubble Bath, Lost Lagoon, Pretty

Peacock

Other: Stippled Roses Dies*, Thoughtful Expressions Dies*, Meadow Dies, 3D Basics Embossing Folder (Dots), Classic Matte Dots, Sponge Daubers, Small Blending Brushes (Optional), Blender Pen, Lost Lagoon Bordered Ribbon

Measurements:

Smokey Slate Cardstock 14.8cm x 21cm (5 7/8" x 8 1/4") Scored at 10.5cm (4 1/8")

Bubble Bath 14.2cm x 15.5cm (5 5/8" X 6 1/8")

Scored in from both sides at 1.3cm and 2.5cm (1/2" and 1")

Basic White 14cm x 9.5cm (5 ½" X 3 ¾")

Inside: Bubble Bath 14.4cm x 10cm (5 5/8" x 3 7/8")

Basic White 13.6cm x 9.6cm (5 3/8" x 3 5/8")

Instructions:

 Centre the 2nd largest outer shape die about 2.5cm (1") from the top of the Basic White layer and cut out. Keep the cut out to use later. Using the 3rd largest shape die place on bubble bath cardstock and cut.

Tip- Centre the die cut white layer onto the bubble bath cardstock without glueing and place the die in center to perfect the placement for cutting the smaller die, see image - remove white layer before die cutting.

- 2. Place the 4th largest die onto the first Basic White die cut piece and cut out. Stamp the sentiment in the center using Basic Gray ink.
- 3. Emboss the Basic White layer with the dotty embossing folder.
- 4. Burnish the scorelines in the Bubble Bath Layer. Then adhere onto the Smokey Slate card base followed by the embossed white layer. Lining up the window (die cut shapes) as you go.
- 5. Adhere smallest die cut and stamped shape inside the window using dimensionals. Place 2 Classic Matte Dots.



- 6. Die cut 1 small butterfly using the Meadow Dies and Smokey Slate Cardstock. Lightly sponge the edges. Adhere to the Basic White embossed layer above the window. Use a small dimensional under the top wing and a glue dot under the body to give the shape some movement.
- 7. Stamp the spray of roses and large leafy branch in Basic Gray ink. Use Bubble Bath, Lost Lagoon and Pretty Peacock inks with blending brushes or daubers to colour the stamped images.
- 8. Cut out using the coordinating dies and adhere to the bottom left of the window with the folded ribbon to the left under the rose spray.

Inside card:

- 9. Stamp the sentiment in Basic Gray ink onto the Basic White cardstock and a small rose in the bottom right-hand corner and sponge the same as before.
- 10. Layer the Basic White layer onto Bubble Bath and then adhere to the card base.
