We're always growing both the number of submissions, as well as employers.

Submission Guidelines

In order to submit your resume and information to the portfolio, the following must apply:

- You must have completed at least one full course (if you were a student prior to May 2023); or you must have completed one full pathway (if you were a student in the May 2023 cohort or later)
- The key indicator is you must have at least one capstone project on your Github
- A Technical Career Coach (Jenny Terry or Kandi Hall) has approved your resume

How to Submit to the Portfolio

When you meet the above requirements, reach out to [Kandi](#) (Eastern KY) or [Jenny](#) (Greater Louisville), to get the submission link.

Keep the following in mind as you submit through the submission link:

- When entering your information, fields such as name and email must exactly match your Code:You enrollment info, or you will get an error (those same items can be different on your resume with no issues)
 - If you're unsure of your enrollment info (ie - you have multiple emails and aren't sure which you used to register, or your legal name is 'Michael' but you think you may have registered under 'Mike'), check with your Technical Career Coach to confirm
- If you are not currently looking, there is an option provided to leave it unpublished for the moment. We can publish at a later time.
- Double check spelling and grammar before submitting.
