Summary



Crossroad is a continent on the north edge of the Square World surrounded by the Frozen Ocean from the north, the Wild Ocean from the east, and the Warm Sea from the west. In the south, it has a border with Pleasant.

Originally it was populated by nomadic tribes and was known to the rest of the world as Unknown. The tribes name their place Sirr (Ground) but don't really appreciate it when anyone else calls them 'ground people', which is extremely politically incorrect.

Crossroad was discovered by the people of Pleasant country, who accidentally got lost during the traditional hide-and-seek event in the foggy mountains.

Gloomhild's Cult



Gloomhild is on of the goddess of the Square World, she has adepts on every continent. On Crossroad her cult has become extremely popular since first people came here through tunnels searching for happiness but forgetting to leave the despondency at their homelands. The oppressive landscapes of Crossroad and the necessity to wait long for the next flight, due to the unstable working of the tunnel system at the earliest stages of its existence, led to the building of numerous temples and monasteries devoted to Gloomhild.

Geography

<u>Landscape</u>



Before the tunnel system was created Crossroad had been a typical tundra place, covered with swamps and dwarf trees, a vast plateau, extending through many degrees of latitude and longitude.

Only in the south some not very tall hills, the Mossy Knolls, appear, surrounding The Warm Gulf in the west and The Whale Gulf in the east. Further to the south, the hills are gradually turning into quite high and picturesque mountains of Pleasant country.

<u>Vegetation</u>
Due to the harsh climate, the vegetation of Crossroad is quite limited. Cold sandy deserts in the north which used to be the bottom of The Frozen Ocean and thousand kilometres of swamps, covered by reindeer moss with sparse shrubs and dwarf trees, represent 90% of the territory. Nevertheless, toward the south curving birches and tiny firs are getting higher and higher, finally growing into quite dense coniferous forests and starting to balance between tundra and taiga situation.

Vegetation of the coastal hills is very specific and is constantly changing nowadays because of the generators. People have managed to grow fruits and vegetables which are not typical for the place. Usually, they grow them for themselves. But there are some local farms that sell their products all over the continent and in some rare cases even abroad.

There are also some scientific projects of the Crossroad Polytechnical University devoted to growing edible plants and developing farms.

Lakes and rivers



Crossroad is rich in lakes and rivers. The estuary of the major river, the Ever-Lasting, is located on the highest hill in the south, called Haya, which could be translated into the modern Crossroadian as 'mountain'.

Other water objects are not very impressive in size. But there are so many of them especially in the north-east that indigenous people call this area Sierkillah Sirr (The Land of Mirrors).



Minerals



Crossroad is rich in mineral deposits. Oil and gas fields are located along the west coast further to the north from Mossy Knolls. Couple of them are on the islands off the coast. An oil extraction project from the bottom of the sea is also being developed right now.

All oil and gas of the continent is used for its own purposes since the south of the continent is a large manufacturing area at the forefront of technology and engineering, which is not only serving the transit station but producing different equipment for the rest of the Square World.

<u>Population</u>

As for the population, Crossroad is a land of contrasts.

The south represents a large densely populated industrialised urban area with the capital Stanzia in the west, having been built around the transit station. And dozens of cities and towns on the coast of the Warm and Whales Gulfs.

So, while the south is a vibrant mixture of fortune-seekers from all over the world, not to mention students and scientists of The Crossroad Polytechnical University, the north is relatively underdeveloped. There you can find nothing but some permanent or temporary camps of nomadic tribes and several temples and monasteries of Gloomhilda's cult.



There are also a couple of company towns belonging to gas and oil fields in the west.

Some kinds of settlements, very close to what we mean by 'fishing villages', may be found in the rural area of the Land of Mirrors and on the north-east ocean coast.

Climate

Northern Part



The climate of the north of the Crossroad is a typical polar climate with year-round cold temperatures, which could drop to -50 degrees Celsius in winter. Periods of hot weather in summer are quite short but temperature may reach even 30 degrees.

Besides the low temperatures, weather here doesn't seem to have any disadvantages. The air is quite dry, the precipitation level is low but with a chance of fluffy snowfalls in winter and dramatical thunderstorms in summer. The sky is clear almost every day.

In February, there is a period of strong north-eastern winds that make severe frost feel even harsher. But the rest of the year is not that windy at all.

West Coast



The west coast of Crossroad has always been warmer than the east one because of the warm waters of the West Sea.

Since the generator appeared the weather here has changed dramatically and quite a mild version of typical tundra climate has been substituted by almost mediterranean one. Especially in the south, on the coast of the Warm Gulf.

The left generator starts working in January and stops for cooling in June. It gives the region a sultry summer and makes it perfect for a beach holiday. During the hottest months - June and July - the average temperature is 30-35 degrees Celsius and the air is close despite the breeze.

By December the generator is completely cooled, but still doesn't start working, which brings a rather nippy winter with fluffy snow flurries and festive atmosphere of the end of the year. The average temperature of winter months is about -20 degrees.

East Coast



The east coast of Crossroad faces cold ocean winds all year round. Besides this fact, the northern part of the east coast doesn't differ much from the rest of the tundra.

The southern part of the east coast is influenced by the right generator, which is located on the shore of the Whale Gulf. The right generator's working period is from July to December, which means quite mild winters and not-so-hot summers. The difference between seasons is smooth. The average temperature of each month is about +15...+20 degrees. The wind chilly factor makes it feel much worse, though. Nevertheless, the weather is never oppressive here, most days are sunny, and worst case - partly cloudy. The average temperature of the water is +10...+15.

As you may guess, the Whale Gulf resorts are not so popular among sunbathing lovers, but they attract surfers from all over the Square World. The water here may seem cold for surfing, but for real fully-equipped, and well-trained wave hunters low temperature is not an obstacle.

Meteorologists of Crossroad are always aware of tsunami chances, although the last big wave hit the east coast more than 150 years ago. Some skeletons of whales and other sea creatures can still be found quite far from the shore.

Animals

Giant Cats' Herds



The symbol of Crossroad is a giant cat. The giant cats didn't appear on the continent by themselves.

They were naturally selected from typical cats when the cult of Gloomhild started to flourish in the north. Gloomhild's followers from all over the world came to the temples of the goddess with their cats which were typically big and fat.

While their owners were praying and serving, cats were dating and giving birth to bigger and bigger kittens, which immediately became popular among indigenous nomadic tribes and gradually substituted reindeer in their herds.



Now herds of giant cats spread throughout the north of Crossroad. Opposite to the typical cats they are not afraid of water and fish in numerous rivers and lakes. Shamans of local tribes managed to tame them enough for catching fish for people. Cat fur came in handy too for making clothes, shoes, carpets, and different household items.

There are some legends about packs of wild nocturnal giant cats which dwell in the Land of Mirrors and go fishing at night. They are even said to be enough organised for hunting in groups for whales of the Wild Ocean. But most people of Crossroad consider such rumours to be just fairy tales.

Whales



Crossroad is the only country where you can see blue whales. It's a marine mammal, reaching a maximum length of 30 metres and weighing up to 200 tonnes. It is the largest animal known to have ever existed in the Square World. Even the giantest of dragons are not comparable.

The blue whale's long and slender body can be of various shades of blue from dark-navy to turquoise dorsally and pure white underneath.

In general, blue whale populations migrate between their summer feeding areas of Frozen ocean and their winter breeding grounds near the Whale Gulf.

They are generally solitary or gather in small groups.

No man of the Square World has ever caught or killed a blue whale, and we don't know what happened to the few who tried.

<u>Ducco</u>

A ducco is a mixture between cows and ducks, artificially bred by biologists of the Northern Biological Institute. It looks like a giant duck, the size of a cow, with hooves, horns, utters, wings, and the ability to lay enormous eggs.

Duccos were an answer for the threat of famine, caused by two reasons. First, the incredible flow of immigrants after the tunnel had started to work. Second, the side effect of generators: for some mysterious reason, the metabolism of people who live next to them becomes very fast, so they have the magic ability to eat a lot and not to put on weight, which may seem wonderful, but give them a permanent feeling of hunger.

However, duccos have become such a typical and natural part of the landscape in the south of the continent, that nowadays you can hardly imagine the green slopes of Mossy Knolls without picturesque herds of these giant birds and their shepherds.

Mythological creatures



Kini is a spirit of the Wild Ocean. He looks like a giant man covered with blue skin. He is athletic and extremely attractive. Legends say that no woman can resist his beauty. He has short white hair, a long blue tongue, and long claws. Opposite to other fabulous sea

creatures he has human legs instead of a fishtail.

Kini is a protector of seamen of all kinds: fishermen, sailors, divers, surfers, marine biologists, and just swimmers.

There are also some stories where he is carrying a big black bird on his right shoulder. Such stories state the day when the bird starts singing will be the last day of the Square World.

Sometimes Kini is said to be a chief of blue whales turning into a human to communicate with people if their activity interferes with whales' life. He can speak ancient Crossrodian but rarely uses this ability.

The legends about Kini became widespread after the last tsunami. A lot of witnesses said they saw him just after the catastrophe. Some blamed him for what happened, some claimed he was trying to save beached sea creatures.

Architecture

Gloomhild's Temples
Gloomhild's temples are the most outstanding architectural landmarks of Crossroad. They are quite small one- or two-storey cabins with walls made of colorful glass or colorful transparent plastic. That allows the northern sun or bright moon to shine you around. Sometimes such temples are covered with a kind of outer curtains.

There is a leaend that the doors of Gloomhild's temples open only for people in real despair. But actually, dwellers of the Square World consider depression to be a kind of severe infection and would never enter the temple unless their conditions are critical just as you wouldn't visit a venereological clinic even if its architecture is breathtaking.

Real fans of Gloomhild come in without hesitation. Usually, they bring their cats, which they leave outside, and mattresses, sleeping bags, blankets, or pillows, which they take in. If you don't have your own mattress temple servants will give you a special gloomy blanket. The believers can spend there a lot of days before Gloomhild lets them go away.

Southern cities

As you remember, all cities of Crossroad are located in the south. The capital Stanzia in the west and some smaller university and industrial cities along the coasts of the Warm Sea and the Wild Ocean represent the architectural style the country is famous for.

Huge multi-storey buildings of glass and concrete might seem boring if not for the original geometrical shapes and asymmetrical lines that may remind you of the futuristic style of Tasty Fire. Opposite to dwellers of Square №1, Crossrodians don't like skyscrapers. Their buildings are rarely higher than 9-10 floors.

You may also admit that most buildings have special spaces for growing plants. Typically, these plants are edible, and such architectural feature is not just a tribute to fashion but also a way to solve the problem of food supply.

<u>Company towns</u> Some company towns are located on the west coast around the oil and gas fields of the continent. People from all over the world come here to earn money and hope to not stay for long. They live in simple, cheap, look-alike blocks of flats with all modern conveniences but nothing more.

Fishermen's villages

Another remarkable type of building on the continent are log cabins of the Land of Mirror. It's a popular place for living on Crossroad if you are not ambitious and ready to work and study 24 hours a day. So, people come here and build cabins that are typical for their homelands - that makes some fishermen's villages look like museums that exhibit wooden architecture from all over the world.

Financial system

Diseases and treatments

#1 Giant Cats Allergy

The specific type of an allergy for cats. Typically, people who have an allergy for regular cats have the same problems with their gigantic version but not necessarily.

Local people, that don't have the allergy, tell stories that this can happen only to people with the dirty souls or with cursed ones.

Which hasn't been approved by scientific research.

Dispite the similarity to the regular cat allergy, symptoms differ.

In most cases, the disease starts after spending some time with giant cats especially if they scratch you. If you have the allergy this scratch starts burning and can not be easily healed.

In a while, patients begin to feel sick.

In severe cases, this harsh condition can be accompanied by psychosis and hallucinations.

<u>Causes</u>
The causes of the disease is being studied actively. We can safely say that this type of the allergy concerns only people with the specific type of the immune system.

Treatment/First Aid

For people who admitted the syptoms of Giant Cats Allergy, first of al, I we highly recommend stopping any contacts with giant cats and ridding of all clothes made of cat wool.

Fashion

On the one hand, clothes of modern crossrodian don't differ much from the outfit of the rest Square World. On the other hand, the specific history of crossrodian people and welcoming policy for aliens from other countries created their own style that couldn't be confused with fashion of any other place.

<u>History of crossrodian fashion</u> The first people who came to the territory of modern Crossroad were inhabitants of Pleasant who just lost in the woods or its scientists who left their square to explore new lands. Typically, they were wearing comfortable clothes like jeans, T-shirts and pullovers. As well as they were not very good at sewing and hardly ever had needles, threads or fabric.

Having crossed the Pleasant mountains, they had to wear their current clothes as long as they could.

Since nothern rivers were rich in copper and the first explorers washed their jeans and pullovers in them for ages their colours tended to turn into all tints of brownish red - from dark chocolate to crimson.

These rusty colours are still considered to be traditional for crossrodians and you can even see them on the flag of Crossroad.

Tunics Fashion Revolution

The next fashion wave also concerns the history of Pleasant. There were times when psychology had just become extremely popular on Pleasant and its pilgrims set off to spread the psychological word all around the world. One of the sponsors of this campaign was a merchant who sold fabric, so the psychological expedition to the north was equipped not only with wisdom but with cotton and linen as well. Actually, they managed to get much further with a word of wisdom and fabric than they could have with a word of wisdom alone.

Nevertheless, north still experienced the lack of sewers despite the intensive contacts with local tribes who were really skilled in making clothes from leather and knitting.

Borrowed some needles from indigenous people our explorers started to make their own clothes from the pilgrims' fabric. Having tried different techniques of sewing and constructing wear they came to the conclusion that tunics are the option that suits their level of sewing skills best.

Since then for several decades, tunics of different colours, gradually faded brick red, were the most popular outfit for both men and women of all ages.

Weeds' Empire

Crossrodian pioneers were moved by two main motives: curiosity that had led them to the place and a strong desire to survive that appeared immediately after they first faced the local winter. They could hardly be blamed in urge to use the clothes for looking either

elegant or sexy or to express their personality through stylish outfit.

The reason that turned Crossroad into a leader of fashion industry was the scientific curiosity and their natural willingness to experiment.

Two twin children, Mannayg and Ikkis, a son and a daughter of the professor of chemistry and a cat driver, were at the age of 8 when the first portion of fabric was brought by pilgrims. Since their early ages the children were charmed of how threads of different fabric crossed, they tried to repeat these patterns with everything that reminded threads: from stems to ropes and wires, they could hear pilgrims' stories about sewing machines with much more interest than their parables about co-dependent relationships.

When grown up, they studied features of local plants and travelled around neighbourhood continents learning fabric production. Having combined their botanical knowledge, modern chemistry achievements, northern magic and sophisticated looms, designed by engineers of the continent, Mannayg and Ikkis founded the weaving industry of Crossroad, set on fabric made of arctic moss, arctic willow, caribou moss, labrador tea, arctic poppy, cotton grass, lichens and moss. That were later complemented by more south plants, especially after the climate change caused by the Kidneys.

Nowadays, Weed's Empire is a large manufacture with their own labs, plant fields, several factories and a fashion house, known worldwide for its original fabrics. They never stop seeking for the new ideas and go on testing new ways of production.

Tunnels

At the very beginning, the Square World had a problem with its transport system. It might have taken years to sail from the north-western continent to the south-eastern.

But then an engineer from Crossroad came up with an idea of a partly magical way of traveling. Using recent scientific discoveries and sophisticated spells Tina Halpaak managed to create sustainable tunnels between different squares which can transfer you a thousand kilometers away in no time.

People of all countries understood nothing about the idea but supported it completely.

When Tina the Engineer finished the project it appeared that wherever you go using these tunnels you should use the square N^o3 as a transit station. And you never know how much time you need to spend there between the flights.

Nobody finds it comfortable. But it makes square $N^{o}3$ the most visited place in the world despite the severe climate.

Since Tina is still the most clever person in the Square World, nobody can understand if it happened because of a miscalculation or if it was a tricky plan of Crossroad authorities to lure people to this unpopular place.

The reason for this engineering solution may also be explained by the need for huge generators.

Building the tunnels and the whole engineering support construction required a permanent source of magic power. For this purpose Engineer and her team created two big generators which work in shifts. These generators produce so much heat that they need to be cooled all the time. So the final constructions were located inside the permafrost layers of the around.

The generators were placed quite far from one another in order to reduce their melting power. While one in the east is working and getting hotter and hotter, another one in the west is resting and getting cooler and cooler. They were located so symmetrically that people started to call them 'Kidneys' straight away.

I suppose, there is no need to mention that the work of these generators has strongly affected the climate of Crossroad and provoked a mixed reaction from its inhabitants, scientists, ecologists, politicians, and indigenous population.

Despite all the difficulties of moving to such a harsh place, a lot of people from all over the world were happy to leave their homelands and settle on Crossroad. Not-so-pleasant people from Pleasant country, talented artists who don't appreciate the idea of being kidnapped, Dead Ice Cream dwellers, and burnout event managers from Triangle Festivals - were welcomed and tried to find their fortune in this severe land.

How does the station look? What documents do you need to have? How much does it cost? How does the process of transportation feel like? Accidents?

How does the station look?

15 Roads and signs

Notices and Warnings

Due to the highly-developed intuition, local people don't typically need special notices and warnings. They could guess that the slope is too steep or which way you should choose to open the door: pulling or pushing.

For regulating their lives, they often use signs that were created artificially but look like something that was made by nature.

Newcomers brought the culture of using words and images for public warnings that found proponents and opponents.

Here you may find some examples of warnings and notices of both kinds, which may seem unclear if you have never been to Crossroad.

Unprotected Mirrors

Unlucky Sign



Since Tina Haalpaak created her shrewd mirrors, it became possible to watch what's going on in any corner of SW if only there is a mirror or any other reflecting surface. So, just after creating the shrewd mirrors, she had to create the way to protect reflecting surfaces from spying.

Of course, it's difficult to provide each pond of SW with such protection, so a lot of places on Crossroad has a sign of a mirror or a crossed mirror. First one – for the places with unprotected reflecting surfaces. Second one – for places with protected mirrors.

Whales

Storm Warning



This is a natural kind of signs. Every time when whales with their newborn cubs come too close to the shore, a transparent wall appears between the sea and the land. The wall doesn't allow fishermen's ships and boats to go to the sea. We call it 'wall' but actually it looks like waves just stop themselves from crushing on the beach,

No Warnings

Food



Once upon a time on Crossroad, there were no typical cafés and restaurants, you might knock at any door and ask if they had any food and how much did it cost. Typically, each family was happy to share their food and serve it in a special 'guest place'.

That way of eating isn't very common in SW so nowadays you may often see this special food sign on the doors of houses and flats.



With new people coming to the continent, a lot of new notices and warnings have come. To protect their places from extra notices pollution, local dwellers use this warning. Quite ironic, though.

Educational System

There is no public compulsory educational system on the continent. All children are brought up traditionally.

Families of the continent typically have their own business, and they don't stop working even if they have small children. They bring their to the workplace and children start their careers in family business straight away from the births. They don't need any special education. All knowledge they get through practice. Of course, for some professions you need to read books for answers and development, but they read these books only when they got such a problem or just because they are interested in this topic.

The disadvantage of this system is that it is not so easy to become a professional in a field your family doesn't belong to.

Anyway, at the age of 12-16 a teenager is supposed to find a job, so-called apprenticeship, outside the family, mostly as a step for gaining self-sufficiency. But also to find their true path in life. Most of the children come back to the family business in 2–3 years, enriched with new knowledge and experience.

Teenagers use this opportunity to move to different part of Crossroad. Typically, this teenagers' job is not very well-paid and families have to support their children financially.

Nevertheless, the day when you manage to find your first job is celebrated as a first day of your adult life, and families arrange a great party.

Hero: Obo



Obo is a small boy from a nomadic tribe of the Wild North. The name of his tribe is Balyksyttar, which means 'fishermen'.

His father, Ro, is a fisherman and a cat herder. Once he met a beautiful girl from a distant country - Anna, who came to the North for praying in Gloomhild's temples. They fell in love and got married a couple of months later.

Obo was born on a clear December night when stars were shining brightly but nobody paid attention because the emerald and scarlet flashes of northern lights covered the sky.

An only child he got all love from his parents. His mom, Anna, used to organize birthdays and other events for children in Triangle Festival, so she brought new games and stories that were not known to Balyksyttar people.

Like other children of the tribe, Obo has helped his mom and dad since he was a baby: catching fish, herding cats, and making shoes and clothes from their wool.

Muscular, with bulging biceps, thick hair, and swarthy skin Obo could be a typical child of the North if not for his freckles which he takes after his mom, and his height which is only 1 meter.

On his second birthday, his uncle gave him a kitty that he accidentally found in the wood while walking to the party. It was an extreme case because local people never leave their cats. Obo fell in love with the kitty immediately and called her Kuoska. She has been his friend and charger for many years.
