# **Expenses**

#### 1. Food:

- a. If you eat all 3 meals in the university canteens, on average it will cost you around HKD 3500-4000 per month.
- b. If you go to off-campus restaurants, the average cost would be between HKD 30-90 per meal.
- c. If you cook at your apartment (or join one of the groups here that cook their own meal), your food expenses might be HKD2500 on average.
- d. For Halal South Asian food, the Pakistani restaurants at Sham Shui Po are very cost-effective. A meat-based dish with 2 chapatis will cost HKD 45-50. A vegetable-based dish with 2 chapatis will cost HKD 35-45. A biryani will cost HKD 35-55.

#### 2. SIM card:

a. SIM cards start at HKD 33 or 48. CMHK and 3HK offer both HKD 33 and 48 SIM cards. CSL and SmarTone start from HKD 48 SIM cards

b. HKUST students can purchase a prepaid SIM card (https://www.sosimhk.com/en/shop.html) for around HKD 33 from the ParknShop in the university. A 7-eleven shop close to HKUST (https://goo.gl/maps/USuTwRKQkD4cak8a9) also stocks SIM cards of HKD 33 (https://eshop.hk.chinamobile.com/en/prepaid-card/detail.html?pid=2326&category=1031 ).

#### 3. Rent:

- a. For the university hostel, current rates can be checked from the website.
- b. If you opt to stay outside, the rent for a single room is around HKD 4,000-6,000 per month.
- c. The rent for a small apartment is around HKD 6,000-10,000 per month.

#### 4. Fees:

- a. The fees can be checked from the website.
- b. Research Postgraduate Students (not Taught Postgraduate Students) who need to support their spouse and kids can apply for a hardship allowance in which the fee is waived off. This is on a case to case basis and one should confirm this with their professor if they and their department would be willing to grant one a hardship allowance

#### 5. Transportation:

- a. For the journey from the airport to the university, detailed instructions plus fares are given here
  - i. HKUST (From Airport/Train Station to HKUST)
  - ii. CityU (Getting to CityU From Airport | City University of Hong Kong)
- b. For traveling via public transport, you will need an Octopus Card that requires a HKD 150 deposit.
- c. You can budget around HKD 500 for the first month to account for any trips you want to make to the city.

## 6. Miscellaneous:

 Laundry, stationary, other expenses could be estimated to cost HKD500 - HKD1,000 per month

#### 7. Initial expenses:

- a. You can budget around HKD 14,000 15,000 for your first month here.
- b. If you plan to bring cash, try to bring HKD
- c. If you can't bring HKD or the conversion rate is bad, you can bring CNY, USD, EUR, GBP etc. and convert a small amount at the airport (Convert the rest elsewhere as you can get better rates in the city)

## Misc Information

## 1. Electrical outlets:

a. Three-pronged UK-style plugs (220V AC, 50Hz).



b. It's better to bring an adapter if possible, otherwise you can purchase those from JHC (<a href="http://www.japanhome.com.hk/eng/brands/jhc/shop-network/index.jsp?area=Kowloon">http://www.japanhome.com.hk/eng/brands/jhc/shop-network/index.jsp?area=Kowloon</a>)

#### 2. Weather:

- a. It is useful to bring an umbrella along, both for rain as well as for UltraViolet radiation.
- In Nov-Dec one might require windbreakers/hoodies because of the windchill.
   Temperature rarely goes in the single digits (Celsius) in these months, but the wind can make things a bit chilly especially when in the open.
- c. Classrooms and labs have air conditioning throughout the year (because of humidity). It can get a bit cold, so better to have a hoodie.

#### 3. Utensils:

- a. If you can bring your own, it would save you both time and money.
- b. IKEA in Kowloon Bay might be an economical option (Kowloon Bay Store | IKEA Hong. Kong and Macau)
- c. You can also buy from Tmall.com

## 4. Bedding:

- a. You might have to bring a pillow, bedsheet, quilt, toiletries etc. as those aren't generally provided in the hostels (double check from their website to be sure)
- b. Again it's better to bring along than spend time and money buying

#### 5. HKID card:

a. You will need to apply for an HKID card within 30 days of arrival if you intend to stay for more than 180 days.

## 6. Food:

a. Bring along at least two meals and some snacks because if you reach here at night, it might be difficult to find an open food place.
