

Cell-Ed: English on the Go (Selected Course)

Summary

General Information

Cell-Ed's general English courses for English Language Learners include six levels with at least 11 units apiece. Each unit has roughly one hour of instruction focused on tasks and topics relevant to the average learners' life (budgeting, writing cover letters, conversations with a teacher, etc.). Each task and topic also includes instruction on relevant speech acts (continuing a conversation, giving compliments, expressing condolences, etc.).

All lessons are supported with short written texts from the instructor and the occasional authentic text, such as work memos or reports, but the majority of input is auditory, including an ongoing conversation from the teacher and brief recorded conversations between different speakers. Learner responses to the text typically come in the form of answering multiple-choice questions, writing a text to complete a sentence with missing words, or responding via text to written or audio questions. From the three units reviewed here (1 unit apiece from "Ingles Introduccion 1," "English Level 3," and "English Level 6"), the most frequently highlighted English Language proficiency Standards were 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, and 10) from descriptor levels 1 - 3 (NRS 2-4).
