

- Polo shirt: light blue/ navy blue/ white
- Navy blue leggings
- White or navy blue Hijab
- Girls (3rd-8th), may wear solid color Abayas on *Fridays* (color of choice)
- * Special events and picture days: Girls are required to wear their navy jumpers, white shirts, and white hijab (6th 8^{th)} *

Boys Pre-K - 8th

- Navy blue or Khaki Pants
- Polo shirts: light blue/ navy blue / white
- * Special events and picture days: Boys are required to wear navy blue pants white dress shirts (with the logo), and a navy blue tie. *

Shoes must be suitable for running. Flip-flops, heels and house slippers, sandals, clogs, Crocs, and boots may NOT be worn any time.

School Hours

- Arrival Time: The school is open to all students starting at 7:30.
- Assembly: The students line up with their classes at 7:50
- Students who arrive after 8:00 will be considered tardy
- Parents of students who arrive after 8:00 must come in and sign in their children.
- First Class: Students must be ready for their first class at 8:00
- Dismissal on Monday-Thursday is 3:45
- Dismissal on Friday is at 2:40

Drop-Off Procedures

You can drop off your child/children at the front door from 7:30 to 7:50. If you need to enter the building to speak to a teacher or attend the assembly, please park your car in the parking lot. The front doors will be locked at 8:00, and students who arrive after 8:00 will ring the doorbell and come in to sign in their child/children at the front desk..

Dismissal Procedures

All students must be at the front lobby at 3:40. Teachers will call the students' names and escort them to their parents' cars. After 4:00, the front door will be locked, and parents who arrive late must sign out their child or children at the front desk.


