 - i. Amend the Operating Rules to include a clear sexual harassment policy
 - ii. Appoint Pilar as the Sexual Harassment Chair to
 - 1. Funnel issues of sexual harassment to Excomm
 - 2. Informally check-in with club members
 - 3. At least once a year, conduct training sessions for employees and VDLS on sexual harassment. These sessions should teach what sexual harassment is, explain that employees and members have a right to a place free of sexual harassment, review the CSC complaint procedure, and encourage employees and members to use it.
 - 4. At least once a year, conduct training sessions for Excomm members at that are separate from the other sessions. The sessions should educate Excomm about sexual harassment and explain how to deal with complaints.

- d. Do we have an environment unfriendly to women at the club? 5:45- 6:00 Security Update: Joel spoke with Ali Endress on 1/23/18 re. The next three issues. We are encouraged to post no trespassing and authorized members only signs.

 - f. 1. Call the police. 510-981-5900. Tell them there is bad history with this person, they are hovering, you suspect ill will. If emergency, dial 911. 2. Tell the security guard. Tell them in person is best. Find their car in the marina. You can also call 1-800-400-1110 Mobile Security. 3. Call the Marina and let them know regarding any incidents or persons of interest 510-981-6740. I spoke with the Waterfront Mangager, Ali Endress, regarding safety, and she emphasized to not hesitate to call the police. It is good for the marina. And use 911 for any potentially harmful situation. They can show that they need more resources. If there is anyone the marina office should

know about, they would like to be notified. And they can also share names with the private security. Additionally, she highly encouraged us to create some signage because it will help the police do their job. She says we should have a "members only/authorized club members only no trespassing" sign in front of the yard and by the stoop, and a "Start Here & Welcome to Cal Sailing Club" sign at the club house.

A.3. Sexual Harassment Policy

Sexual harassment is defined as any unwelcome sexual advance or conduct that creates an intimidating, hostile, or offensive environment. Any conduct of a sexual nature that makes a member or employee uncomfortable has the potential to be sexual harassment. CSC will not

tolerate sexual harassment and will discipline any wrongdoers. The procedure for filing sexual harassment complaints is by contacting the Sexual Harassment Chair at complaint@cal-sailing.org. CSC will investigate fully any complaint received and will not tolerate retaliation against anyone who complains about sexual harassment.
