The district is required to submit a plan as part of the next round of federal funding. We will continue to be guided by the State of CT, The Department of Public Health and our local health officials. ESSER II funding has been awarded and we are working on the American Recovery Plan Grant. Our plan is to create our reopening plan and resume normal operating procedures related to school day, school year, lunch and transportation. We will not be offering a virtual learning option next year. We will look to the state to see if they will be offering that service regionally. We will seek feedback from our stakeholders on the grant. Most of the plan will not be under the discretion of the Wallingford Board of Education but in the hands of the State Board of Education.
