State Reporting

ISASP

3rd-11th grade students will soon begin with ISASP testing. HS students will participate in these assessments next week, along with the MS students over the next two weeks. West Elementary students will begin these assessments April 18th and Virtual and interested HSAP students will test the last week in April. Preliminary data for the district assessments will be shared by early summer, with published student reports at the beginning of the 23/24 school year.
