# How to track and increase page views for images on the Wikimedia Commons

## Find or create categories of photos you want to track

Most tools use Commons categories to track images. If you do a mass upload, be sure to include a category common to all the images you upload so that you can track usage.

Tracking categories are a "<u>hidden category</u>" --on Commons, see Preferences>Appearance>Advanced Options>Show Hidden Categories to make them visible

I made "Images from the Harold B. Lee Library", which is the category I'll use in the demos and screenshots below.

## Add uploaded images to Wikipedia pages where appropriate

- If there is a relevant page
- If your image is a higher-res version of an existing popular image--go ahead and replace it with the better image!
- If you know where the photo was taken, it could be added to the page about that location (only if there aren't existing, better images).
- On foreign language versions of a page (visual editor makes this easier). I recently
  added an image of Pitman shorthand to several foreign-language versions of the page.
  You can use <u>GLAMify</u> to find pages on other language Wikipedias that could use images
  that are already being used on your "home" Wikipedia.
- Adding multiple, relevant images to a less-popular page improves the page and adds a
  lot of image views. If you have four images on a page that gets 10 views a month, that's
  40 images views a month.

## Tools to track page views on the commons

### GLAMorgan

#### **GLAMorgan** shows

- views of pages in a specific category in a given month
- shows page views across different language Wikipedias

 may over-report for newly added photos (i.e., counting views of a page as views of an image before the image was added to the page). However, it counts previous views of an image newly added to the category.

#### **GLAMorous 2**

#### **GLAMorous** shows

- Pageviews in a specific category over a single month or a larger interval
- "Global file usage" shows how many images are used in foreign language Wikipedias and how many views those images receive
- Shows views across all language Wikipedias under "file usage details" (doesn't show views "per" language Wikipedia like GLAMorgan)
- Can show a graph of daily views over time (under "daily views")!


