FY'2026 CENTRAL ILLINOIS CONTINUUM OF CARE NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY**Local Application Deadline: August 19, 2026, at 5:00 pm CST**

On June 1, 2026, HUD released the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the FY'2026 funding cycle. The NOFO can be found at [HUD 2026 CoC NOFO](#). This NOFO has had a procedural ruling against it, and HUD has vacated the competition. That said, we believe a very similar NOFO will be released after the required public comment period has been met.

The Central Illinois Continuum of Care has been engaged in preparations for this funding opportunity, which includes the review of new, renewal, and transition project applications. We have completed our first round of Application scoring and ranking, and have determined **we are reopening the competition process for a balance of \$47,637.**

For those interested in competing for funding, a local application must be completed to be considered. Please be sure to follow attached application instructions to have your project considered for funding. Additional Applications are due Wednesday, August 19, at 5 pm CST. Late Applications will not be reviewed for funding.

Utilize **New Project Application** for eligible new projects (including CoC Bonus and DV Bonus*). The NOFO gives details on funding set-asides for projects serving specific subpopulations, see NOFO for more information. All New Project Applications must be one of the following component types:

- Transitional Housing
- Supportive Services Only - Standalone
- Supportive Services Only – Street Outreach
- Rapid Re-Housing
- Permanent Supportive Housing

All renewals from FY'2025 continuing with the same project type utilize **Renewal Application**.

For renewals seeking to transition to a different grant component type, utilize **Transition Grant Application**.

****Please note that funding to support new projects may be contingent upon the CICoC application scoring high enough to be awarded Bonus Projects. HUD requires a 25% match for all awards. The match can be in the form of cash, in-kind or revenue.***
