GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Communications may be written in Spanish or English.

Communications will be sent in two formats:

- The first will be used to compile a dossier with the translated presentations, which will be given to event participants. This is the text that will be read at the 9th CIARC.
- The second will be the revised and expanded version. It will be published in the journal AARC-Actas de Arquitectura Religiosa Contemporánea, following peer review at the end of the conference.

FORM 1

It will be sent no later than October 15, 2025.

- Paper size: DIN A4 : width 21 cm, height 29.7 cm.
- Margins: top 3 cm, bottom 2 cm, left 3 cm and right 2 cm.
- Arial 10. Single line spacing.
- Justification will be on the left.

Presentation

- Papers must be written in Word or similar and should be between 1,500 and 1,800 words in length, not including notes or a bibliography.
- Personal text styles must not be used.
- *Italics* may be used to emphasize words or phrases. CAPITAL LETTERS should be avoided in both titles and text.
- In enumerations, only single hyphens (-) must be used.
- Headers and footers are not allowed.
- There will be no numbering on the pages.

Biography

- At the end of the document, authors should include a brief biographical sketch (150 words) outlining the key points of their career, emphasizing areas of scientific interest.

FORM 2

In addition to what is indicated for Form 1:

- The text will be sent WITHOUT IMAGES, in editable format.
- Papers will be between 4,000 and 5,000 words in length, not including notes or bibliography.
- A folder with 10-15 images in jpg format will be sent, named as follows: Fig 01.

Charts, tables and images

- Each image will be sent as a separate file (jpg).
- Its minimum size will be 10 x 15 cm, 300 dpi resolution and good contrast.
- Photo captions should be written as follows: Fig. XX. Architect, Building, City (Country), dates; details (if applicable).

Notes

- They will be included at the end of the article, and only must be explanatory, never bibliographical.
- They will be numbered in parentheses from the number (1).
- ¹ will be used in the body of the text to reference them.

References and bibliography

- Bibliographic, periodical, and archival references must conform to the criteria established in The Chicago Style (Author-Date), 16th edition, available on the conference website (Papers). The text must include, for example, (Frampton 2005, 35).
- Only references expressly cited in the text will be included.

Source of images

- In a specific section, the source of images must be indicated (The Chicago Style [Author-Date] edition 16).
- In the case that they are the property of the author, it will be done in this way: Fig. 01. Author's archive.

PRESENTATION

- For the in-person presentation, the text from Format 1 must be used.
- For the presentation of communications (15 min.), it is recommended to use between 10 and 20 images (PPTX, PDF, etc.), distributed more or less evenly throughout the presentation.
- The moderator will notify each speaker when they have 2 minutes remaining.
