1. Door-to-Door Knocking

As a participant, you'll be actively involved in knocking on the homes of the Evesham community members to engage in friendly conversation about Easter and to just inform them of Evesham Fellowship Church. We have specific Easter literature to give out if people want to know more, and also prayer cards for prayer requests and a free bible pamphlet for those who would want a Bible. At this ripe period, where people have the theme of Easter and Christ's resurrection in mind, it's a great opportunity to make connections with the members of the community and whatever the outcome may be at each door, seeds will be planted which will be further watered through other means in the future.

If this is your first time don't worry, you'll be going out in pairs for support and encouragement. We'll also provide training prior to the outreach to help you to know more about the church you will be connecting them to, what to expect and some tips and pointers that will help you on the doors.
