



BISD STAAR PARENT PORTAL INFORMATION

The Texas Assessment Student Portal provides students and parents with online access to a student's state assessment scores. This portal will assist students and their parents in tracking assessment information throughout the student's academic career, including specific student responses, and provide guidance on ways to support the student in the future.

The portal provides scores from the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR), STAAR Alternate (includes STAAR Alternate 2), and the Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS).

Your child's STAAR/STAAR ALT 2/EOC/TELPAS scores are accessible through the Ascender Parent Portal. Follow these steps:

1. Log in to your Ascender Parent Portal by clicking "Families" in the top corner of our bowieisd.net website or use the following link.

STAAR Performance Standards Label	Symbol	Student Result
Did Not Meet Grade Level		<u>Did Not Pass</u> Shows a lack of understanding of course expectations and content; the student needs significant support next year and is required to do 15-30 hours of Accelerated Instruction.
Approaches Grade Level		<u>Passed</u> The student has some knowledge of the course content but may be missing critical elements. The student may need additional support in the coming year.
Meets Grade Level		<u>Passed</u> With a strong knowledge of course content, the student is prepared to progress to the next grade.
