P3 Presents the 9th Annual Virtual Principal EdCamp

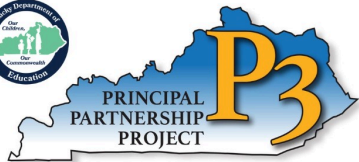

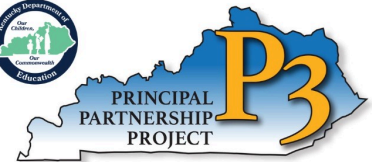

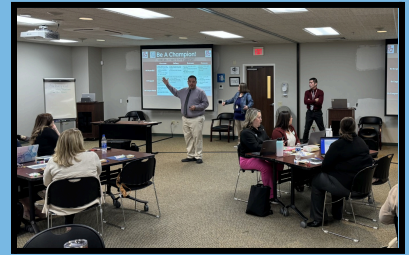


KY Assistant Principal Cohort Kick-Off

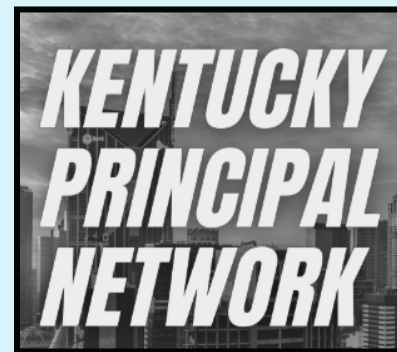

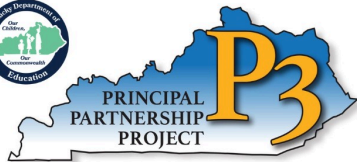

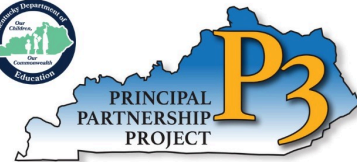

School-Based Decision Making Handbook

Each School-based Decision Making (SBDM) council has the responsibility to set school policy that must be consistent with district board policy and provide an environment to enhance students' achievement and help the school meet the goals established by KRS 158.645 and 158.6451 and goals for the district established by the board. The purpose of this handbook (revised in May 2024) is to provide detailed information regarding SBDM processes, laws, and best practices. The topics covered in the handbook assist school council members, local SBDM Coordinators, and trainers in meeting those responsibilities.
