



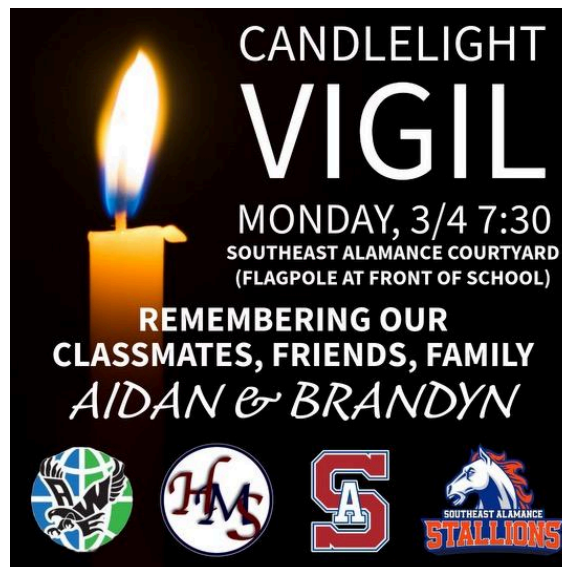

ABSS Transfer Window: The window to request a transfer to a school outside of your assigned zone for the 2024-2025 school year is March 1 through April 1, 2024. The form to request a transfer is available on the ABSS website and will be turned off on April 1st. It is linked below.

If your student already has an approved transfer, it is in effect through the grade span (K-5, 6-8, 9-12). If your student is at the end of the grade span, you must re-apply for a transfer to attend a school outside of your assigned zone. Per Board Policy, if your student is granted a transfer, they may be ineligible to participate in ABSS athletics for 365 days.

NC Check-In Math: This Thursday, we will administer the Math NC Check-In to all 6th - 8th grade students. NC Check-Ins are interim assessments aligned to North Carolina grade-level content standards developed by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI). The main purpose of NC Check-Ins is to provide students, teachers, and parents with immediate data and a reliable estimate of students' current performance on the selected content standards. **It is extremely important that your student arrives at school on time on Thursday to ensure that our test administration can begin on time.**

HMS Bookfair: The Scholastic Book Fair will be coming to Hawfields soon! Students will be given an opportunity to preview the Book Fair on Friday, March 8. Each grade level will be given the opportunity to make purchases during their Social Studies classes on the following days:

- Tuesday, March 12 - 6th grade.
- Wednesday, March 13 - 7th grade.
- Thursday, March 14 - 8th grade.
