- When did you feel like you wanted to get involved in language work?
- Can you describe the current situation of your language(s)
- Highlights of your work over the years?
- Things that would make this work easier?
- Where do you find inspiration?
- If there were three of you/if you had three interns
- What is your relationship with other groups? What kind of support would you like?

- Consent and Licensing Review
- Email you a digital copy of consent
