Maintaining Health and Safety Mitigation strategies listed below (a-i) are required in the District's plan.

- a) Universal and correct wearing of masks (please see plan below)
- b) Modifying facilities to allow for physical distancing (e.g., including use of cohorts/podding) (please see plan below)
- c) Handwashing and respiratory etiquette (please see plan below)
- d) Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation (please see plan below)
- e) Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the State, local, territorial, or Tribal health departments (please see plan below)
- f) Diagnostic and screening testing (please see plan below)
- g) Efforts to provide vaccinations to school communities –Wood River Rural Schools will work with local agencies including but not limited to The Central District Health Departments and Wood River Fire and Rescue to assist in the voluntary administration of COVID-19 vaccinations as well as the use of district communication platforms to share information regarding vaccine clinics to the school community. Students and staff will not be required to be vaccinated.
- h) Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies. Wood River Rural Schools Special Education staff will collaborate with parent/guardians in determining the Individual Education Plans for students with disabilities as it relates to their health and safety due to Covid-19.
- i) Coordination with State and local health officials. Including the needs for support and technical assistance to implement strategies consistent to the greatest extent practicable, with relevant CDC guidance. Ensuring Continuity of Services: Wood River Rural Schools will ensure student learning by providing assignments when they are home sick or quarantining. Additional instruction maybe provided as needed when the students return to school. Students will be given extra time provided in policy for when they are sick or quarantining. After school study hall, the after school program and Saturday School are options for students who need additional help.

Student social emotional wellbeing and mental health is a top priority for our schools. Students can seek counseling services with our guidance counselor and/or community mental health counselor. Supports through the Leader in Me curriculum will be utilized on a weekly basis. Students health needs will also be addressed by our registered school nurse. Students will also receive free breakfast, lunch and after school snacks.

Public Comment Requirements: In July of 2021, a parent survey will be conducted to gather input on the return to school plan. Wood River Rural Schools will use the feedback to make adjustments to the plan.

The plan will be revised at least every 6 months and maintained in an understandable and uniform format; to the extent practicable written in a language that parents can understand or, if not practicable to provide written translations to a parent with limited English proficiency, will be orally translated for such a parent; and upon request by a parent who is an individual with a disability as defined by the ADA, will be provided in an alternative format accessible to that parent.

Below is a chart of actions that the district could potentially take based upon the health department's recommendations. At this time, we will start the school year in the green. A number of factors are considered in transitioning from phase to phase. Including the number of Covid-19 cases within the schools, communication with the Central District Health Department, Department of Education, the Governor's Office, and School Board.

When to quarantine:

If COVID-19 Positive:

Student may need to stay home for 5 days. If student is fever free on day 5 and no other symptoms, the student may return to school on day 6. Student recommended to wear mask for the remainder of the 10 day period.


If student continues to have symptoms on day 5 they may need to stay home until fever is gone or other symptoms are improving.

****DAY 0 IS THE DATE OF YOUR POSITIVE TEST OR FIRST DAY OF SYMPTOMS.**

****DAY 1 IS THE FIRST FULL DAY AFTER A POSITIVE TEST OR YOUR SYMPTOMS START**

Wood River Schools will work with the CDHD and follow CDC guidelines. It is recommended that those testing positive for Covid-19 follow this protocol.
