Principle

2. The development and implementation of policy must have a basis in and adhere to standards of fairness, notice, transparency, integrity, objectivity, predictability and due process consistent with ICANN's core values and its commitment to the global public interest as outlined in the the ICANN Articles of Incorporation

Recommendation related to community

Whenever the Board discovers that the recommendations of the GNSO do not, in their view, reflect a broader consensus based on the advice of the Advisory Committeees or public comments, it will use existing process mechanisms to either send the issue back to the GNSO for further consideration or initiate broader community discussion. All final recommendations would still be the responsibility of the GNSO.
