# Elgin Early College High School Strategic Planning Document 2024-2025

#### STRATEGIC Priorities for 2024-2025

## **Objective 1:**

Meet TEA blueprint designation requirements in all three areas: Access, Attainment, Achievement

Previous Outcome: ECHS did not meet Access Outcome Based Measure Criteria for designation in 2023-2024.

#### **Action Steps:**

- 1. Work with PEIMS to identify student indicators for every applicant.
- 2. Target at-risk and economically disadvantaged students at a rate that meets or exceeds the district %
- 3. Utilize student ambassadors in the fall and spring to recruit students (at-risk & economically disadvantaged)

#### **Objective 2:**

Meet or exceed a 95% student success rate each semester.

**Previous Outcome:** The student success rate for the spring of 2024 was 95%.

#### **Action Steps:**

- 1. The intervention process was created and reviewed thoroughly with all ECHS/PTech high school personnel.
- 2. Communicate more frequently with parents/guardians about program updates, deadlines, and events.
- 3. Grade Check forms
- 4. Saturday School

# **Objective 3:**

Create a positive culture, climate, and sense of belonging.

**Previous Outcome:** Student interviews in January 2024 found that the student desires a more engaging and positive experience in the program.

## **Action Steps:**

- Create a student activity account and conduct fundraisers to begin taking more field trips and bigger incentives for students.
- 2. Start a parent volunteer group for ECHS and PTech to develop event and incentive ideas.
- 3. Invite parents to program meetings and assign some a seat at the table as a key stakeholder.

#### **Objective 4:**

Rewrite and plan curriculum Scope and Sequence and Unit Overviews for Pathway to College & Career I-IV

**Previous Outcome:** Curriculum framework for the Pathways to College & Career (PCC) course needs improvement.

## **Action Steps:**

- 1. Revise the scope and sequence documents for PCC I-IV
- 2. Re-vamp Unit Overviews and include new programs such as EdReady and other resources

## **Objective 4:**

Retain 75% or more of at-risk & economically disadvantaged students per cohort

**Previous Outcome:** 42% of students were retained from the class of 2024. This was 33% below the OBM target for ECHS.

# **Action Steps:**

- 1. Implement new TSI Prep materials and schedule proper teacher professional development for them.
- 2. Follow the program intervention plan
- 3. Student conferences in PCC
- 4. Look into the PSAT and English II STAAR scores as another option

## **Objective 6:**

70% or more of the freshman cohort passes the TSI ELAR test by the end of their first semester

**Previous Outcome:** 47% of the freshman cohort passed the TSI ELAR test by the end of the first semester in the fall of 2023.

- 1. Emphasize the importance of TSI through coordinator and counselor visits in the classroom.
- 2. Have students take TSI during their PCC classes (twice in the Fall and twice in the Spring).
- 3. TSI Refresher Courses offered after school and on Saturdays
- 4. Implement new TSI Prep materials and schedule proper teacher professional development for them

# Objective 7:

50% or more of PTECH students stay on track for an Associates Degree of Applied Science.

**Previous Outcome:** Class of 2023 only had 1 PTECH student graduate with an associate's degree.

- 1. Emphasize the importance of TSI through coordinator and counselor visits in the classroom.
- 2. Have students take TSI during their PCC classes (twice in the Fall and twice in the Spring) as Freshmen.
- 3. Have ACC Success Coach meet with students about more opportunities post-high school.
- 4. Emphasize and implement the intervention process with PTech more frequently and consistently.
