

Sense Ability July 2025 Mary Magdalene

In this issue, we are learning all about Saint Mary Magdalene, who is sometimes called “Apostles to the Apostles” because she was the first one to see our Risen Lord and shared this news with the disciples. After Jesus’ resurrection, Mary Magdalene found our Lord in the garden and gave him a big hug! Scripture tells us in John 20:17-18:

Jesus Said, “Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, ‘I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.’” Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: “I have seen the Lord!” and she told them that he had said these things to her.

After sharing this joyous news with the apostles, tradition tells us that she continued to spread the Good News of Christ with the world. Along with the apostles, her efforts began the amazing revelation of Christ to the whole world!

For today’s sensory bin, we’re taking a simple puzzle of the whole world and hiding the pieces under your favorite sensory material- we chose popcorn kernels!


Supplies needed:

- Popcorn kernels or other filler
- 2 copies of world map (provided)
- Glue stick
- Tongs

Instructions:

Print 2 copies of the map we’ve provided with the QR code. Take one map and cut out each of the continents separately. Hide these pieces under your popcorn kernels. Provide tongs for the children to find the pieces. Once they’ve found the pieces, they can glue them onto the matching continents on the other page. Practice naming the continents as you work and remind the children that God’s message of salvation is passed down from the apostles many years ago to all of us today!
