What is 'Streams'?

Streams or Students' Conference on Islam and Muslim Societies is an event organized by the Faculty of Islamic Studies of the Indonesian International Islamic University (UIII) Depok. The event is designed to provide a platform for students to present their research and receive feedback from their peers and experts in their fields.

The conference will select the best 30 master's and PhD students around Indonesia and overseas to present a variety of fields under Islamic studies, such as (but not limited to) Islamic legal discourse, Islamic intellectual history, political Islam, theology and philosophy, digital Islam and humanities, and anthropology of Muslim societies.

Am I eligible? How do I get involved?

The primary targets of participants for the conference are graduate students pursuing a master's or doctoral degree in the fields of Islamic studies or other related fields, such as social sciences and humanities, as long as the research is on Muslim societies.

The Streams organizing committee welcomes extended abstracts (individual work) within 300-500 words in English or Arabic. The abstract must clearly address the following aspects:

a. Problem statement b. Significance of study c. Research question d. Main argument e. Methodology; along with 3-5 keywords and 150 words (max) short biography.

The participants should arrange their own transportation to the UIII campus in Depok, West Java. The committee will only provide accommodations at the UIII apartment for the participants.
