Family passes down \$100 wedding dress for 72 years

So far, eight brides spanning three generations have worn¹ the special dress.



For more than seven decades, one family has upheld² a special tradition of passing down the same wedding dress. Now, they're continuing the custom by preserving it for a new generation of relatives.

Overall³, eight brides have worn the same wedding dress. Adele Larson first wore the classic satin gown⁴ at her wedding to Roy Stoneberg on Sept. 16, 1950. The traditional dress features a mandarin collar, a lace panel in the front and back, and lots of small, fabric-covered buttons. She purchased⁵ it at Marshall Field's department store in downtown Chicago, now home to Macy's State Street, according to her niece, Julie Frank Mackey. "She bought it for \$100.75, which, in this day and age, is kind of wild," Mackey, 42, told [...]. "When you see it up close, the fabric, the satin and the lace⁶ are just really, really gorgeous and timeless⁷." [...]
