THESIS SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

INSTRUCTIONS

Read and complete all of the steps on this checklist before submitting your thesis. 95% of theses that are returned for corrections did not meet one or more of the following criteria.

- ☐ **Save your thesis:** Save your thesis as a PDF/A (Archive) file
- ☐ **Title page:** Use the current [Thesis Title Page template](#)
- ☐ **Specialization:** Ensure your specialization, if you have one, is correct. You can confirm your specialization on Bear Tracks.
- ☐ **Bibliography:** Your bibliography must be at the end of your thesis but before your appendices. Do not place a chapter number on your bibliography. There may be some duplication in some situations.
- ☐ **Abstract:** Place your abstract immediately after the title page and label it as page "ii." Use double spacing throughout your abstract. Do not include graphs, charts, tables or illustrations.
- ☐ **Prefatory pages:** Prefatory pages must be numbered (except for the title page) using lower case Roman Numerals (i.e., i, ii, iii and so on) and must appear in the correct order, as shown in the [GPS Minimum Thesis Formatting Requirements](#).
- ☐ **Thesis title:** The thesis title must match the title on the online e-thesis deposit form in ERA.
- ☐ **Page numbers:** Ensure all pages of the thesis, beginning with the Introduction or Chapter 1, are numbered consecutively with Arabic numbers (i.e., 1, 2, 3 and so on). This includes pages containing tables, figures, illustrations, the bibliography and appendices.
- ☐ **(Optional) Creative Commons (CC):** If opting for Creative Commons (CC), ensure it is included on the Thesis Approval/Program Completion form (TAPC), Thesis Deposit Form and the thesis itself.
- ☐ **Name:** Ensure your name on the thesis and all forms submitted to GPS matches your name on Bear Tracks.
