

POSTMASTER GENERAL REQUIRED TO HAVE POSTAL EXPERIENCE

Washington State

WHEREAS: The postal service has seen great upheaval in the structure and operation of its core mission to serve the American public all in the name of becoming financially solvent, and

WHEREAS: The last two postmasters general have not had any experience working as the postal service prior to becoming postmaster general, just private management experience, and

WHEREAS: The finances of the postal service continue to become more insolvent while service standards and staffing have been reduced leading to the American public questioning the ability of the Postal Service to provide reliable and reasonably priced service for such important events as vote by mail.

RESOLVED: That the APWU National Executive Team launch and national campaign to encourage Congress to pass legislation requiring all future Postmasters General be required to have a minimum of 5 years of Postal Service prior to becoming the Postmaster General.
