Membership of the branch is free but, to be a member of the branch, you need to join the BSAOC first and nominate the Cheshire Branch as your chosen branch. However, anybody is welcome to attend as a guest, if you just want to sample the atmosphere or come out on the occasional run.

Our riding season is from 1st March – 31st October and in a typical year we organise about three runs per month. There are local runs, maybe only 25 miles, finishing at a local fish and chip shop for example, or long distance runs when we might stay over a couple of nights in a hotel in Yorkshire. We've even been abroad to Brittany and to the MotoGP in Assen. In 2025 we organised nearly 30 runs.

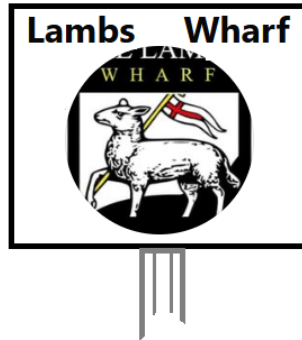

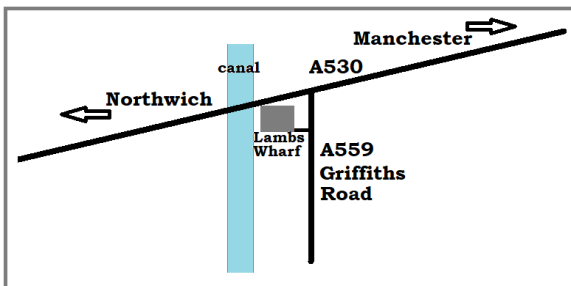


...which is a biker-friendly pub on the outskirts of Northwich, previously Wincham Wharf Marina

Some of our members have been tinkering with BSA motorcycles for many years and they are happy to share their expertise.

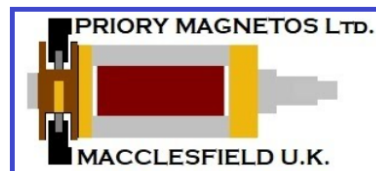
Amongst our members are owners of most of the popular BSA's from the 1940's through to the last models made in the early 1970's.
