Zvidryn is the eldest child of Indem, a proud, and powerful member of the clan Ensis Fumoveo. But they are prominently known as a peculiarity, a *contract* child between Arbiter and Ensis Fumoveo. Rather than boasting about their exalted promotion as squire to Commander Kazahana— they let their actions speak louder than their words.

## Personality

---

Zvidryn for lack of a better word is often described by their peers as a brooding and blunt type of dragon. Rarely withholding their sharp tongue, no matter how cruel hearted their opinion may seem, they are not afraid of speaking the truth and care very little of the blowback they would receive in response to others. Nor how they are perceived by strangers for their callous nature. Only the small few acquaintances they associate with and close family members of Ensis Fumoveo see Zvidryn's true intent behind their words and actions.

But on the battlefield— Zvidryn is a violent, merciless, and ruthless Ensis. A stark contrast to their usual demeanor, striking fear into the hearts of their enemies— and laying them to rest amongst the ancestors.

## History

---

Zvidryns existence should have been one of joyous recognition, whether out of love or strictly honor-bound. But neither was the case; they were born from much darker, unwanted, and unforgivable circumstances that could have brought the very downfall of the clans involved—in theory if not for the discretion of both parties, that was paid in full with blood and coin. A formal ‘contract,’ a cover up, was agreed upon, rather reluctantly, by Ensis Fumoevo to protect their parent, Indem's reputation and to save the face of Arbiter, having the situation reach the Guard.

Their parent—Indem would have a clutch of two which were split between the clans as per their arrangement. Despite Indem's protests, their words had fallen upon deaf ears to Arbiter, and were far too weakened from egg laying at such a young age to put up a fight properly. Their egg—covered with shades of blue, and brown hues, accented with brighter blue electric markings, would be kept by Ensis Fumoveo, and their clutch sibling would be relinquished to Arbiters—a fleeting moment, a spark of connection, a bond that would never get the chance to bloom fully was severed in an instant. A feeling of a subtle surge was gone all too soon.

But as quickly as the electric feeling dissipated it was replaced by an enveloping warmth, a presence of fire, and a voice that spoke of such love and care throughout their incubation. They knew not of anyone else but their voice alone soothed their newly kindled spirit—as they continued to grow, they couldn't wait to see the one who spoke to them so fondly. When weeks finally turned into months—their egg soon began to stir ready to hatch.

### ***Hatching (2940 — 2948)***

When Zvidryn hatched in 2940, unbeknownst to the hatchling they were born with prominent traits of an Arbiter, with their wing markings and evident neck patterns on their saturate scales. Their gaze instinctively went to Indem, and their vibrant, saturated colored scales hearing their voice and finally being able to place a face to their parent at long last.

Sometime after their hatching, their parent Indem brought them to their ancestral cradle of Ensis Fumoveo in Stone-Edge Keep. Where they would spend the majority of their livelihood eventually learning their clan's history and rich heritage. Although Zvidryn would adamantly stick by their parent's side like a little shadow— noticing Indem's tired and almost saddened state.

They would constantly place their tiny little paws on their bigger ones trying to initiate small actions of play or games of chase. The young hatchling took notice of how their parent would lighten up with these small actions— so they strived to keep doing it to make their parent happy and in doing so would deepen the bond they shared. Zvidryn would soon discover their element a few years later at the early age of 5.5 years old, a saturated blue hue of electricity from their maw.

They had very few moments in their early years as a hatchling when on numerous occasions they had to openly speak in words to express themselves properly. Some of the family at times began to speculate if the child was *mute*— being simply incapable of speaking but in truth they had so many thoughts in their tiny little mind that it became difficult to openly communicate.

Zvidryn was only comfortable with confiding their thoughts to Indem— they weren't entirely shy spoken; it was naturally easier to speak to their parent. On many occasions, the family had to learn the hatchling's motions and with a little encouragement from Indem to speak their mind instead of letting their thoughts fester even if it was little or brief responses.

It wouldn't be until the early age of 7 years old they started to speak up more when spoken to by anyone else in the family that wasn't their parent with the usual small gestures of their body to convey themselves.

## **2964 — Present**

When the time arrived for their enlistment into the military their parent Indem's words spoke volumes that would resonate with their spirit— guarding their heart both physically and mentally. They kept their fellow dragons at a distance beyond the usual

working related environment. They felt little desire to pursue a deep connection with another dragon which suited Zvidryن just fine as they remained steadfast in their career as an infantry soldier— of the 19th Regiment under the renowned Patriarch of Everwinter himself, Commander Kazahana.

But they still couldn't fully shake the oddness in their heart, a lingering pit in their stomach *missing* their matched set. A matched set that never was and their parent Indem presence became far more profound— being alone without another Ensis who would stand by their side as they moved, and fought in unison on the battlefield. An experience for the next two years that would truly push Zvidryن to the ultimate test of wills and mental fortitude.

## Abilities

### **Element**

Zvidryن's is set above average at an exceptional **Class Five**. Their control over both their breath and element manipulation is a true spectacle to behold— with their cutting edge bladework befitting of an Ensis.

### **Magic**

Zvidryن is not capable of using any form of magic, nor have they made any attempts to do so.

### **Physical**

A rather robust yet agile dragon— befitting their element Zvidryن is quick on their feet, and highly versatile in the art of combat. Easily cutting through their opponent's and prey alike defenses like a bolt arrow.

### ***Indem***

Zvidryns devoted parent— who help shaped them into the formidable Ensis they are today. They are often described as kindred spirits amongst their family members. Sometimes when words are not enough to express their gratitude and gratefulness for having them in their lives. Although they can be quite overprotective of their parent's well-being— and harsher on those who may try to intrude in their personal space unannounced.

### ***Kazahana***

Zvidryns commander, a living enigma incarnate although they speak highly of their commanding officer. Understanding the true nature of the Everwinter himself, took many years to understand their movements, their actions, and reading between the lines. But they often describe him akin to the futile effort as trying to predict a raging blizzard— nearly impossible to comprehend.

- Zvidry's voice claim is Keanu Reeves.
- Once they become an elder they are estimated to reach around the size of 6.3m.
- Zvidry favors the art form of Bladetracing akin to their parent Indem; they have been in awe of their display ever since they were a young hatchling. They practice the martial arts often in and out of combat and are often called upon to showcase their skills during Ensis ceremonies.
