**Question 1 (Helpful Tips - Reading):** Read the laboratory safety guide: "Students must wear safety goggles at all times. You shouldn't eat or drink near the chemicals. If a chemical spills, you have to inform the teacher immediately. You ought to keep your workspace clean to avoid accidents." Identify one **rule**, one **prohibition**, and one **piece of advice** from the text.

**Answer: Rule:** Students must wear safety goggles. **Prohibition:** You shouldn't eat or drink near chemicals. **Advice:** You ought to keep your workspace clean.

**Question 2 (Helpful Tips - Writing):** Think about school rules (e.g., being late, cheating). Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) about the **possible consequences** if a student doesn't obey these rules. Use "if" or "will." **Answer:** If a student arrives late to class, they will miss important information and disturb the lesson. If they continue to break the rules, the school administration will call their parents. Consequently, they might receive a suspension or a low grade in conduct.

**Question 3 (Food and Festivals - Reading):** "Mexican cuisine is famous for its spicy flavors, using chili peppers and beans. In contrast, Japanese cuisine focuses on fresh, seasonal ingredients like raw fish and rice with a mild taste. Mediterranean cuisine, like Turkish or Greek, is rich in olive oil, vegetables, and herbs." Classify the three cuisines mentioned in the text based on their main ingredients. **Answer:** 1. **Mexican:** Chili peppers, beans, spicy flavors. 2. **Japanese:** Raw fish, rice, fresh ingredients. 3. **Mediterranean:** Olive oil, vegetables, herbs.

**Question 4 (Food and Festivals - Reading/Diagram):** Read the text: "The Rio Carnival in Brazil is a huge street parade with samba dancers. In China, the Lantern Festival marks the end of the New Year with colorful lights. In India, Holi is the festival of colors where people throw dyed powder at each other." Create a simple list or diagram to show the **Festival Name**, **Country**, and **Main Activity**. **Answer:** \* **Rio Carnival** -> Brazil -> Samba street parades.
