Director Reports

International Services:

- Peace Pole - someone ripped off the pride sticker (getting this replaced)
 - Bench is also there but signs are needed - Bob shared mockups at the meeting
 - Cost for the signs will be approximately \$2000 and this will come from international budget
 - Joan mentioned that we need to make sure we have the proper Rotary brand info
- Comfort Cabinet - This is in the library and provides personal items for those in need.
 - 2500 personal care items have been distributed
 - Bob made motion to maintain the comfort cabinet for one year. The cost is \$5400 for our half.
 - Joan seconded the motion
 - All in favor
- Bob will also work on international projects once the budget is approved

- This would be under Bob's international services and Bob will review this
 - Della and Duncan will share the bulletin with Bob
