What is an NTI day and why do they exist?

The Non-Traditional Instruction Program (NTI) is a program that encourages the continuation of learning on days when the entire district is closed due to bad weather or safety concerns. Our goal is to continue instruction on these days as much as possible. This is a required day of school for students so all NTI work should be completed just as it would be at school.

How does it work?

There are two options for work completion- one digital option for students who will use technology at home, and one paper/ pencil option for those who may not have access to technology at home. Teachers have determined which students will utilize technology and which need a paper/ pencil packet.

What if I need help on an NTI day?

All teachers are required to have 3 “office hours” for each NTI day. They will communicate to you whether that will be from 8-11 or from 12-3. During this time, they are available to communicate with you and will do so in a timely manner.

When is NTI work due?

All assignments are due on the first day that we return from school after an NTI day(s). Teachers have to turn in records of student work completion so please do your best to ensure your child’s NTI work is completed.
