

MASTER OF NURSING: 4-YEAR PROGRAM SCHEDULE

50 total degree credits. 35 credits of core (BNURS) and 15 credits of electives. For electives, students select from the school's health elective coursework (BHLTH) and from 400-600 level courses across the tri-campus system (Bothell, Seattle, Tacoma) to fulfill the elective credits. Students may opt to complete one or more electives in the summer quarter.
