Listed below are the updates for the week.

### **Parent Communication Tips - Call vs. Email**

One trend that has occurred over the past 10 years is that less and less people make phone calls. I am there with you, but there are times when picking up the phone is the best option. As a school district, we have set the expectation that staff will respond to calls or emails within 48 hours or two (2) business days. However, there are times when 2 days is too long based on the reason for the communication. With the fact that in our jobs, we are not in the office or at our computer a lot, sometimes we may not see an email for 24 hours. **If there is something that needs more immediate attention, please call the appropriate person or leave a message with the office to have the staff member call you or check their email for a message from you.** You can still send the detailed email, but the call will get it on our radar more quickly, so we can work together to ensure a timely response to a more pressing issue.

### **PowerSchool Data Breach Follow-Up**

We want to provide an update on the PowerSchool data breach reported earlier this month. After further investigation, it has been determined that "Student Table Data" was accessed. For our district, this includes directory information, such as student names, grades, and parent contact details (addresses and phone numbers). This type of information is comparable to what might be shared through a formal records request to the district. We also want to clarify that no sensitive information, such as Social Security numbers, was accessed. While some districts have reported breaches involving this type of data, our district does not store Social Security numbers in a way that would make them vulnerable to such an incident. We are continuing to monitor PowerSchool's communications and will provide any new information if it pertains to our students.

### **SHS Textbook Community Review/Feedback - Spring 2025**


