Bert Young, a 1928 EHS graduate and charter member of the EHS Athletic Hall of Fame, was a track, football, and basketball star throughout high school.

Young received a trophy for scoring the most points in track as a Freshman and was unbeaten in the 440 yard dash in 1926. He also went on to score 15 out of the 26 points his track team scored at Districts.

Captain of the basketball team, Young also earned Honorable Mention on the All-Conference Team 1926. In 1927, he achieved another All-Conference honor in football as well. In 1929, Young went on to qualify for state in track, where he won the 440 yard dash. (Written by Lexi Trimm)
