Responsibilities:	• To provide vision and direction for the Cantonese Congregation under the guidance from the Senior Pastor and in alignment with the overarching vision of the church. • To preach and to teach in Cantonese. • To supervise and to equip other ministers and lay leaders serving in the Cantonese Congregation. • To develop lay leaders and collaborate with them to achieve the missions of the Church. • To provide pastoral care to the congregation. • To lead evangelism efforts in the local neighborhood, nearby communities, and through global missions. • To make disciples of Christ. • To attend UDB and Church Council meetings. • To perform relevant administrative duties as required to fulfill ministerial functions. • To perform any other tasks as directed by the Senior Pastor.
