Long title	A Constitutional Amendment to Require the Executive Branch to Publish Reports/ Minutes on Their Meetings
Author Summary	This resolution amends both the All-Campus Constitution and the Compiled Code and aims to increase the transparency of the Central Executive by requiring all future administrations' Executive Committee and Cabinet reports to be posted on the CSG Website.

Section 1.

The Central Student Government Assembly finds and declares all of the following:

WHEREAS,

The Executive Branch has posted Cabinet Minutes and Executive Committee meeting minutes to the Central Student Government website in previous administrations; and,

WHEREAS,

This practice allows for the student body to access the progress and discussions made by the Executive Branch; and,

WHEREAS,

There is no consistent rule on the requirements of sharing Executive meeting reports, thereby leaving this mode of transparency to the hands of each CSG administration; and,

WHEREAS,

Standardized documentation and publication of Executive Committee and Cabinet meeting minutes would hold The Central Executive at the same standards that the Central Legislature¹ is required to uphold; and,

WHEREAS,

This resolution amends the All-Campus Constitution² by adding specific requirements of the Executive Branch for publishing reports/minutes (see Appendix A), and additionally includes a Compiled Code³ amendment that specifies the consequences of violations of these document retention and publication policies (see Appendix B).

Section 2.

THEREFORE it is, by the Students of the University of Michigan, through Central Student Government:

RESOLVED,

That the amendment contained within Appendix A is proposed to the students in the March 2024 election in the form of the following question, where the text “an amendment” will hyperlink to a PDF of Appendix A.

The CSG Assembly has requested your approval on an amendment to the All-Campus Constitution. This is what the proposed amendment would do:

1. Require the CSG Executive Branch to publish Cabinet meeting reports and Executive Committee meeting minutes to the public through the Central Student Government Website.

Do you support these changes to the All-Campus Constitution? Y/N

AND FURTHER RESOLVED,

That this amendment, upon adoption by the student body and the certification of the election where it is considered, shall apply to those executives elected in the March 2024 elections or appointed thereafter, and all future executive officeholders.

AND FINALLY RESOLVED,

That the Compiled Code is amended in accordance to Appendix B.

Appendix A:

Constitution of the University of Michigan Ann Arbor Campus Student Body

Article III

The Central Executive

208 SECTION 4. THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND CABINET. The Executive may create a Cabinet consisting of the
209 President, Vice President, Treasurer, Student General Counsel, Speaker of the Assembly, and other Executive officers. This
210 Cabinet may serve as the President and Vice President's advisors. The Cabinet is part of a larger Executive Committee, 211
which includes all members of the Executive Branch and its various Commissions and task forces.

212 The Cabinet must produce, publish, and maintain a Cabinet Register as an account of all Cabinet
213 proceedings. The Register must minimally include attendance and reports of all discussions. This Register must
214 be available to all members of all branches of Central Student Government and published to the public through the
215 University of Michigan Central Student Government Website within seven days of the Cabinet proceeding.

216 The Executive Committee must also produce, publish, and maintain an Executive Committee Register as an account
217 of all Executive Committee proceedings. The Register must minimally include minutes, attendance, and reports. This
218 Register must be available to all members of all branches of Central Student Government, and published publicly through
the University of Michigan Central Student Government Website within seven days of the Executive
220 Committee proceeding.

Appendix B:

Compiled Code: Central Student Government of the University of Michigan

Article IX: Code of Conduct and Ethics

4. Transparency of the Central Executive.

4.1. Executive Committee/ Cabinet Transparency Violations. Negligent or willful violations of the document retention policy stated in Article III, Section 4 of the Constitution constitutes an ethics violation regardless of when the violation was made.
