Introduction to CACREP-Accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling Programs

According to the [Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Programs \(CACREP\)](#), there are two forms of accreditation: institutional and specialized. While institutional accreditations evaluate the entire institution, specialized accreditations, such as CACREP, look at individual programs within an institution. Programs that are CACREP-accredited are standardized across the board and are designed to meet the licensure requirements of all states.

Clinical mental health counseling degrees are for students who are looking to provide individual and group counseling to people with mental health disorders. These programs often center around courses such as assessment and diagnosis, counseling theories, and treatment planning and interventions. Clinical mental health counseling is the most popular specialization of counseling for students due to the high need for mental health counselors and the ability to use this degree to work in other specialties.

Choosing a CACREP-accredited master of counseling program has many benefits, like ensuring the quality and content of a counseling program meet standards set by the profession. Additionally, CACREP-accredited programs streamline the licensure process by meeting program requirements in almost all states. While many states do not require applicants to graduate from a CACREP-accredited program, this allows for easy portability of licenses.

Professionals after graduating from this program often work in community mental health clinics and private counseling practices.

Key Highlights:

- Can be completed in 2 years, the lower end of the average completion time for counseling programs.
- Meets licensure requirements for the State of Texas.

Additional Considerations:

- While this program is offered completely online, two mandatory face-to-face intensives held on campus are required to evaluate students' professional dispositions and counseling skills.

Licensure Pathway for Clinical Mental Health Counselors

Requirements for Clinical Mental Health Counseling licensure vary by state. Some of the requirements that you may run into while applying for licensure may be related to education and coursework, standardized tests, and the number of hours of internship.

For example, almost all states require you to graduate with 60 graduate credit hours in counseling. Many states require students to complete courses in Theories, Ethics, and Diagnosis to become licensed counselors. Another step to licensure includes a practicum and internship. Practicum can be held on campus in a student clinic or in the community. Most internships will be outside of the university at community mental health clinics, private practices, schools, and hospitals. Most practicums consist of 100 hours of service, and internships have 600 hours under the supervision of a licensed supervisor.

After completing all educational and practicum/internship requirements, students may be required to pass a standardized test before becoming licensed. In some states, you may practice under supervision without testing, but in others, you must pass both the [National Board for Certified Counselors \(NBCC\)](#) exams. One exam offered by the NBCC is the National Counselor Examination (NCE), and the other is the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Examination (NCMHCE).

Finally, once all educational, practicum/internship, and examination requirements have been met, you are ready to become a Clinical Mental Health Counselor. If you'd like to gain further credentials beyond your state licensure, you may also apply for National Counselor Certification through the NBCC. This credential is not required to be a licensed counselor, but it does stand out on a resume. It also does not require you to have graduated from a CACREP-accredited program, but that does streamline the process, as the NBCC will not have to audit your educational and supervised experience before granting you the credential.

How to Choose the Right CACREP-Accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program

Several factors go into choosing a CACREP-accredited clinical mental health counseling program. Some of the components of a program that you should consider when choosing an accredited program include the cost of the program, how long the program takes to complete, and what specializations are offered by the program. If you have multiple interests in the counseling profession, some programs offer dual specializations, such as mental health and school counseling degrees.

When deciding on a clinical mental health counseling program, you can make a wishlist of desired features. From there, you can make an informed decision that will not only meet the requirements for licensure but also fulfill your wants and needs.

FAQs About CACREP-Accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling Programs

- What is the difference between a CACREP-accredited program and a non-accredited program?
 - CACREP-accredited programs all follow [CACREP's 2024 standards](#). This means that these programs will all have courses similar to other accredited programs and have internship requirements. CACREP-accredited counseling programs will also require all students to take and pass a comprehensive examination.
 - Programs that are not CACREP-accredited may be similar to those that are accredited in terms of course material, but they may also have courses that are based on the institution's values that differ from other programs.
- Can I complete all my studies online?
 - Yes! There are many programs offered completely online, with courses being either synchronous or asynchronous. Depending on the program, there may be requirements for on-campus residencies where students will visit campus every few semesters to check in. It is important to note that while courses may be online, most practicums and internships are done in the community in which you live.
- How long until I qualify for licensure?
 - This varies state-by-state. In most states, once you graduate from your program, you are required to take and pass a standardized counseling examination, and then you may apply for dependent licensure. However, in other states, you must wait up to two years before applying for licensure to gain supervised experience.
- Will my program be accepted if I move to a new state?
 - If you choose to enroll in a CACREP-accredited master's of counseling program, your program will likely be accepted for licensure if you move to a new state. However, if your program is not CACREP-accredited, you may be required by your state licensure board to take extra courses from an accredited university in your new state to meet licensure requirements.
- Do I need to take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or write essays?
 - It depends. Many programs do not require the GRE for admission. However, most programs do require applicants to complete an essay, usually on the topic of why you want to be a counselor, experience in the field, etc. Also note, many programs require an interview for admission that may either be done virtually or on campus.

How to Apply Step-by-Step

- Prerequisites

- All master's in counseling programs require you to complete a bachelor's degree. Depending on the program, you may be required to have a degree in psychology or a related field. However, there are many programs where the bachelor's degree prerequisite may be in any field of study.
- Many master's of counseling programs require applicants to have an undergraduate GPA of at least 2.7/4.0 before applying. This may vary by program, with some programs allowing a lower undergraduate GPA if applicants show promise in doing well in their program or by submitting GRE scores.
- The [Graduate Records Examination \(GRE\)](#) is a standardized test used to determine the aptitude of incoming graduate students. Many counseling programs are doing away with this, but it may be required. Make sure to check the admission requirements for your specific program to determine GRE requirements.
- Application Components:
 - Application components vary based on program and institution, but some common requirements include: undergraduate or transfer transcripts, an essay/personal statement, letters of recommendation, and a resume. Some programs may also require an interview process.
- Timeline
 - Depending on the program, students may apply for admission in all three semesters (Fall, Spring, and Summer) with rolling admission. However, for smaller programs, admission may only be during the Fall and Spring semesters, with strict deadlines on when to apply for each semester. The time it takes to hear back from a counseling graduate program admissions varies, but can be as short as a few weeks. Due to admission requirements like interviews, the process for applying for a counseling graduate program may be more strenuous than other degrees.
- Financial Aid (FAFSA, scholarships, etc.)
 - When applying for any university or college program, the first step should be contacting the school's financial aid office to determine its [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) requirements, even if you do not plan on taking out student loans.
 - After the FAFSA, check in with your program to see if there are any scholarships available through the university.
 - Some programs may offer a graduate assistantship where you work on campus for money taken off of your tuition.
 - After you have looked into federal and state resources and what your program offers, you may visit some sites that offer private scholarships, such as [Unigo.com](#), [Scholarships.com](#), and [Teach.com](#).

Next Steps

Choosing a CACREP-accredited online master's of counseling program is important because it eliminates the concerns of receiving a "degree mill" degree. Programs that are accredited meet the requirements for licensure in most states and offer program portability between states if you

decide to move. On top of those benefits, choosing an online accredited program allows you to complete the program on your own terms and have continuous access to course materials.

If you are interested in furthering your career as a Clinical Mental Health Counselor, the next step would be to look into which programs are of interest to you and start visiting them. Most programs can be visited in person or virtually. Finally, start getting your applications out there. It is important to choose a couple of programs of interest just in case you do not get accepted to your first choice. Good luck!
