

UINTAH RIVER CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL

Dress Code 04-402

In the interest of health, safety, cleanliness, decency, and decorum among students at Uintah River High School, the Board has adopted the following regulations:

1. Students will wear Uintah River High School approved uniform consisting of matching shirts provided by URHS (can't be altered to show abdomen). All pants/shorts/skirts must be 3 inches above the knee or longer (holes or tears must also follow this guideline in length). All clothing and accessories must not display the colors red or blue.
2. Accessories and other personal adornments which display inappropriate language or illustrations, or which promote violence, alcohol, drugs, or tobacco are prohibited at school or at school-sponsored activities.
3. Accessories and personal adornments which display gang symbols are prohibited at school or at school-sponsored activities. Definition: Gang symbols include any article of clothing, badge, sign, lettering, hairdo, jewelry, emblem, symbol or other personal display or adornment, which is intended by a student, or is recognized or acknowledged by students, to designate a gang or to signify affiliation with, participation in, or approval of a gang.
4. In all matters relating to individual dress and grooming, students at Uintah River High School are required to exercise good judgment, exhibit responsible behavior, and endeavor to reflect respect for themselves, their school, and their community.
5. Nothing in these regulations is intended to intrude on the constitutional or statutory rights of any student, as long as, on the exercise of these rights, students do not create a threat to the good order of Uintah River High School or cause the disruption of any recognized school function. The exercise of such rights by students must be consistent with the public purposes for which public schools have been established.
