Responsive Reading Exodus 33:7-23

Isaiah 29:8 dreaming of food, awaking hungry with no chance to eat...spiritual follows physical. Are we spiritually hungry but not filling ourselves with that which satisfies?

Lam. 4:9 are you pining away for that which does not fill?

Exodus 16:3 the children of Israel complain...

Deuteronomy 8:3 He humbled the people to prove them that they might learn to trust and follow Him and spiritually trust and feed on His Word and truth alone...

Matt. 5:6 they earnestly desire to see God

John 6:35 come to Him and hunger no longer

Philippians 4:19 God has promised to supply our needs...

Exodus 33:13, 18 Moses as leader and believer--show me Thy way and Your glory!

Matthew 12:34 What's in your heart? What are you speaking?

Colossians 2:9 Jesus is God and we must know HIm in His perfection & walk with Him closely.

John 16:12-15 He gives us what we need as we need it through the Spirit of Truth, the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 1:17 Ask for the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Christ from the Father of glory.

Psalm 46:10 Be still and know...

James 4:8 Spend time with Him and He will be with you. If you have committed sins, and we all have, confess it, get under the blood of Jesus, pray, worship, sing, talk to God. Spend time with Him! Keep a short list of wrongs. Ask the Lord to examine your heart. Expose the heart motives and get under His lordship.

Psalm 51:10-12 Ask God to create a clean heart in you. Don't leave me and cast me aside. Don't remove Your Holy Spirit. Restore joy. Uphold the penitent with God's spirit, not man's ...don't have a divided Heart or divided loyalties between God and self or the draw of the world, between faith and unbelief.

Remember that the right hand of God is fellowship and relationship through the work of Jesus Christ and the love of the Father for us with the working of the Holy Spirit in us. The left hand of God is judgment and potential wrath. We are not appointed to wrath, but can walk out from under His right hand. Don't do it.

Philippians 3:7-11 Relationship with Christ is worth leaving all behind and giving all to Him.

Mark 8:34-35 Take up your cross and give up your worldly life for a close and intimate relationship with Jesus.

Psalm 5:12 He promises to bless the righteous with favor as a shield

Psalm 30:5 His anger is but a moment, but His favor is life and joy.

Psalm 84:11 He gives grace and glory and withholds nothing good from those that walk uprightly. Be in His presence, be wholly sold to Him and walk away from the draws of the flesh and the world. Jesus Christ IS both grace and glory for His people.

John 1:17 Moses got the law to reveal sin; Jesus brought grace and truth to redeem us.

Romans 5:20-21 The law shows sin and its pervasiveness; Jesus brought grace which is stronger still and through Him reigns righteousness until eternal life by HIm.

Exodus 33:18 Prove yourself hungry for God's presence and glory first, then call on HIm as Moses did. Be a worshipper and a person of prayer!
