

Volunteer Job Description (Unpaid)

Position Title: Vet Clinic Volunteer

Location: Kent Shelter

JOB OBJECTIVES: To provide cleaning services and logistical support to the Vet Clinic staff.

REPORTS TO: RASKC Volunteer Program Manager. Other RASKC staff and designated volunteers may also provide supervision.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL SKILL REQUIREMENTS:

- Standing with frequent bending, kneeling, stooping, and reaching
- Lifting and carrying heavy items, i.e. bags of towels and garbage
- Exposure to active surgery, handling items that may be contaminated with blood and tissue, handling needles or other sharp objects
- Willingness to work independently

- Attention to detail
- Generally available only for adults (18 years and older)
- Not eligible for court-ordered community service
- Note: preference may be given to currently active volunteers with exceptional performance

PRIMARY JOB DUTIES:

- 1. Cleaning & wrapping surgical instruments
- 2. Laundering gowns, surgical laundry, and blankets
- 3. Cleaning empty cages
- 4. Cleaning up urine/feces/vomit as needed
- 5. Scrubbing the prep table and surgical table, sinks, and other work surfaces
- 6. Removing garbage, recycling, and soiled towels
- 7. Sweeping and mopping
- 8. Replenishing supplies
- 9. Taking dogs out for a short walk, especially prior to surgery

TIME COMMITMENT:

• 50 hours or about 16 shifts (or 3 hours every week for four months).

TRAINING & ASSESSMENT:

- New volunteer orientation
- On the job training provided

NOTE: This volunteer position does not allow for the following, unless explicitly authorized by Vet Clinic staff:

- No touching or handling any animals unless explicitly authorized by Vet Clinic staff
- No feeding any animals unless explicitly authorized by Vet Clinic staff
- No administering medication to any animal
