

Hello ASD families this video is a quick overview of Symbaloo. Symbaloo is your student's earliest landing page for many of the technology tools used within the Auburn school district.

Students can find Symbaloo by clicking their home button, or within Auburn school district homepage. Student and staff Chromebooks automatically load to the Symbaloo student page when initially logging into their devices.

Symbaloo is helpful for students because it contains many important links and resources for students to learn online. There are several sub groupings that contain important tools within them as well.

For instance, if students are looking to access their school's homepage, they would click on the ASD schools logo to open all of the individual school sites.

There are also links available for online textbooks, chromebook help, and skyward student access. For middle school and high school there are links to a password reset portal and a quick email access.

Students can access their Google Classroom and Google Drive through Symbaloo as well.

Important instructional tools can be found linked through our CLEVER single sign on portal. Clever stores student login credentials were important programs like Wonders, IXL, I-ready, and Remind. Our most commonly used online tools and learning resources available for students and teachers can be found on cross symbol.

Students will use the two tabs intended for students titled student and primary. The primary tab has many of the same links that the student tab but contains some resources that are designed more for our pre-K and kindergarten classrooms.
