The Issue

What's in YOUR water and lawns? Displays the relationship between chemical applications of pesticides on our lawns and the impact on our drinking water and human health, especially neuro-toxicity to children. Did you know that the typical suburban lawn is so saturated with pesticides and fertilizers that the soil can not hold any more and most of it simply runs off?
