Kathryn (Kat) Kirkman is a fourth-generation military veteran following both of her parents, grandfather, and great-grandmother into service. In her spare time, Kat is actively involved in a number of organizations including serving on the VA Center for Health Equity Research and Promotion's Veterans Community Advisory Board and the Service Academy Selection Board for Congresswoman Scanlon. She is also the Veteran Coordinator for Homecoming 250 and co-founder of the women veterans' group, Sisters in Wellness.
