What is the purpose of the Continuous Progress Report?

The Continuous Progress Report provides families with real-time information regarding your child's progress and achievement on grade-level benchmarks. This progress is aligned to the MN State Academic Standards which outline what every child should know, and be able to do, in each subject area and grade level. We firmly believe that this reporting process will be an effective tool for communicating student growth within the grade-level learning standards.

What it is	What it is not
Indicates what students know and are able to do on-going	Final measure of a student's knowledge for that target.
Measures a student's progress towards proficiency	Measuring work completion, missing assignments or final assessment scores
Indicates if a student is progressing toward mastery	Final measure of a student's mastery level. Students able to continue to work toward mastery
Is authentic to the learning experiences of students based on complex tasks	Not based on rote memory of a concept or Learning Target

The elementary grade book can be accessed by families via the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus. For families familiar with how our secondary buildings use Infinite Campus grade book, it is important to note that the elementary reporting experience is different. Student learning will be reported as instruction and assessment occurs throughout the school year with final grades posted in June. Please note that grade-level standards represent the year-end benchmarks. Therefore, students may be still developing toward most of these standards throughout the course of the school year.
